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TSUNAMI AID

Hello Darwin and Laura Lee.

As my name was included by Doyle Carter in your prayer requests as a source for sending aid to Michael Hubert in India, I thought I would clarify briefly what I do. I am a member of the Bay Area Church of God here in San Francisco pastored by Jeff

Henderson. We are independent but aligned with CGOM (Church of God We have been Outreach Ministries). involved with Michael Hubert and his ministry for a few years now. What we did to facilitate getting money transferred to Michael was open a dedicated checking account with an ATM card and sent Michael the ATM card. Deposits we make are available to him usually the next day. The cost is simply \$1.50 per transaction which is much much cheaper than wiring money. It should be noted that International money transfer methodologies are changing and other low cost methods are opening up too,

especially for larger amounts to countries that do a lot of business with the USA. The only disadvantage I have found with the ATM card method (and it is a small one) is that most banks limit the withdrawals to around \$200 a pop, so larger donations can cost a little more depending on how many withdrawals it takes.

If anyone wants to do this on their own, they are welcome to call me and I will explain further. My phone number is (707) 738-5946. If anyone wants to use the account our church has for Michael, they can email me and I will give them the account number and they can do a direct

deposit if they live in an area serviced by Citibank. Alternatively anyone can send a donation to our church treasurer:

Any monies already sent to me off the prayer request are OK too. I simply forward them to Cathy and anyone who wants a tax deductible receipt will get one from our church group for any donations.

A few of us here in northern California are in process of creating an organization called ACTNet. ACTNet is an acronym for Active Christians Together Network. ACTNet is all about GOOD WORKS. It is our perception that there is a real need for such a network to serve the sabbatarian particularly our brethren community overseas. Sending financial aid to brethren overseas is complex for many reasons and everyone will benefit from sharing in the dynamics of this wonderful and Godly endeavor! It is our hope that ACTNet will be a place where churches, ministries and brethren can go to share missionary projects together, share information, share know how etc. Several Proverbs tell us that there is a synergy created when people unite together that far exceeds the sum of our individual efforts.

The business world knows this, the sports teams know this and try to practice it. We in the Body of Christ are not as dynamic in this area as we should be and could be.

I will share more about ACTNet as we move along into 2005. We are in process of building a web site which will be up and running soon. Our first large project will be a 40 foot container of used clothing, shoes, Bibles, church literature, computers to be shipped to Benin in west Africa. ANIMALS OF ISRAEL by Jeffrey Caldwell Cupertino, California

There's a new book out, Discovering Natural Israel by Michal Strutin. In recent years she has made many visits to Israel, concentrating on the nature preserves and national parks and interviewing Israeli biologists. The book describes the natural world of Israel today, area by area, beginning in the far south at Eilat and the Red Sea coral reefs offshore, working north through the Negev deserts, the Judean desert and hills, and Galilee, all the way to Mount Hermon in the north. She studied all parts of the country.

The biological diversity, for such a small country, is remarkable. The flora and fauna of Europe, Asia and Africa come together there, with elements typical of European forest and scrub, Asian steppes and deserts, the Sahara and even of the jungles of Sudan. Israel is an incredible corridor for migratory birds, with about 500 million birds crossing its skies twice a year!

In Israel, as elsewhere in the world, many animals have become extinct or endangered, especially in recent times. But Israel has been a leader in the restoration of depleted species and reintroduction of extirpated species. Lions were hunted out in Crusader times. Bears persisted until the last known specimen was shot in 1918. Crocodiles and cheetahs also survived until early in the 20th century. There are no plans to restore lions, bears or crocodiles! Leopards still persist and are being carefully studied. Populations of their prey animals are being restored, so the future of the leopard looks good in Israel.

The magnificent Arabian oryx became extinct in the wild, planet-wide in 1972, but Israel has begun reintroducing them into her desert areas, and also the wild ass. In more northerly areas, the extirpated roe deer are being re-introduced. The Persian fallow deer had also been lost to Israel's wilds, but has already been successfully reintroduced. The ibex had been in trouble but with increased protection is now thriving, along with various species of gazelle. Wolves, striped hyenas and jackals are doing fairly well. Some of the other notable mammals of the country include European hedgehog, desert hedgehog, Egyptian fruit bat, dormouse, hyrax, Indian crested porcupine, red fox, badgers, marbled polecats, otters, Egyptian mongoose, wildcat, sand cat, marsh cat, caracal, and wild boar.

Between guns and agricultural poisons,

large birds of prey had suffered greatly in Israel, with some of the more spectacular species coming close to extinction. In Israel, as in the U.S.A., great efforts are being made to restore the birds of prev. Notable species include the white-tailed eagle, Bonelli's eagle, griffon vulture, Egyptian vulture, lappet-faced vulture, and steppe eagle. Storks, both black and white, pass through Israel in migration in large numbers. There are also white pelicans, glossy ibis and great white egrets. A very small bird of prey, the lesser kestrel, which actually lives in Jerusalem, has been targeted for a program of providing nest boxes. The lesser kestrel formerly nested in cavities under the tile roofs of homes, but those sorts of roofs aren't as prevalent now, so they are pushing nesting boxes. One of the many interesting small birds of gardens is the Palestine sunbird, which is a flowervisitor.

Among their reptiles are hawksbill sea turtle, loggerhead sea turtle, chameleon, desert monitor, desert cobra, and the Palestine viper. The fire salamander, basically a European species, reaches its southern limit in moister areas of the northern half of Israel. I learned that the Saint Peter's fish of the Sea of Galilee [which is actually a freshwater lake on the Jordan River] is a Tilapia.

This letter is continued from Issue #24, pages 9 & 10.

Jeffrey writes:

The key to understanding God's command about Pentecost is not history -- it's an understanding of the actual method of reckoning He commanded. But the alleged extra biblical history of that reckoning -- whether representing a history of correct or mistaken practice -- and whether history authentic or bogus -- has a way of influencing our way of thinking about it. Even actual biblical history can be misleading if misinterpreted.

Laura writes:

Use your Bible, because your Bible is the greatest history book you will ever have in your possession. The key is that the scriptures on any given subject must fit together like a glove from Genesis to Revelation. One cannot throw out scriptures just because one scripture seems on the surface to contradict another scripture.

People misinterpret history as well as the Bible all the time. That is why we each individually need to study each different subject on our own as we can. If we follow the teachings of someone who did misinterpret the Bible or history, then our view will also be wrong.

Here are some more scriptures which you would have to make fit in with your teaching that it is okay to follow the Sadducees teaching in regard to Passover and Pentecost:

Acts 23:6 But when Paul perceived that the one part were Sadducees, and the other Pharisees, he cried out in the council, Men and brethren, I am a Pharisee, the son of a Pharisee: of the hope and resurrection of the dead I am called in question.

Acts 23:7 And when he had so said, there arose a dissension between the Pharisees and the Sadducees: and the multitude was divided.

Acts 23:8 For the Sadducees say that there is no resurrection, neither angel,

nor spirit: but the Pharisees confess both.

The above scriptures are yet more proof that the Sadducees don't believe in a resurrection, angel's or spirits of any kind, but the Pharisee's do. To follow a Sadducee would be like following a Sunday keeper and at the same time expecting the Sunday keeper to teach you when the correct Sabbath is.

Now look at the next scripture:

Acts 26:5 Which knew me from the beginning, if they would testify, that after the most straitest sect of our religion I lived a Pharisee.

Here Paul is acknowledging that there were different sects of religion and that the Pharisees were the straitest sect of religion.

Jeffrey writes:

As for extra-biblical historical references -- surely you agree that they vary in quality. And in motive. A lot of bogus history is cooked up or seized upon to support partisan points of view! The Liar promoted the first recorded point of "bogus history" to mislead Eve!

Laura writes:

Yes, I do agree that historical references do vary in quality. That is why one needs to read many sources and always see if the Bible clearly backs it up. Remember the Bible is the greatest historical work you have in your possession.

Jeffrey writes:

I've been amazed to see brothers zealous to obey God who, without realizing it, take their clues from ultra-liberal scholars, letting a far more theoretical than real scholarly "history" of a supposed "evolution" of the weekly Sabbath influence their Sabbath-keeping practice. I know people who believe the Sabbath is lunar --that it resets every month, and can land on any day of the week as generally understood -- persuaded in part by

Arguments relying on extra-biblical knowledge, especially when witnesses conflict, can never persuade me to come to a strong conviction. The extra-biblical 'knowledge' fueling calendric controversies -- regarding what supposedly was "really" happening in the first century -- stems from sources that for me are obscure and difficult to assess for veracity and integrity. Scholars love to guess and often disagree. Partisans care little for the actual facts of a matter.

Laura writes:

You seem so down on history, yet in several areas you are also having a hard time believing the proofs found throughout scripture. Again, I suggest that you study the different subjects more deeply on your own. At first use only your Bible and those reference works which will help you with the meanings of the original Hebrew and Greek words used. Later perhaps you will understand how to fit historical records in that actually prove the Bible is true.

Jeffrey writes:

God knows, based on what you've presented, it remains -- sincerely -- doubtful to me that the Pharisees controlled temple practice in Christ's day and that *every* Pentecost -- as you seem to believe -- of "the faith once for all delivered to the saints" -- is a Sivan 6.

Laura writes:

It is not our job to convince you of anything. Everything that you learn in regard to the law of God is between you and God.

I believe we could probably both agree that God does put things in regard to His law in front of all of his elect so that they might more clearly understand what he wants of us according to His law. When someone presents us with something we haven't heard before, it is our responsibility

Laura writes:

I believe that if you were truly reading this newsletter, you wouldn't even have to ask the above questions.

Exodus 19, is where we go to find one of the first recorded Pentecosts. In my article titled: Biblical Evidence in Support of a Sivan 6 Pentecost. This article written by me, which appeared in Issue #20 on page #18, was all from the Bible, with Strong's being used to help with a better understanding of the Hebrew.

Leviticus 23, is where we go to learn how to count to Pentecost and I covered this quite thoroughly when I answered a letter from Richard Kraft, which appeared in Issue #16 on page #5.

15 The father of the young woman and her mother shall then submit the evidence of the young woman's virginity to the elders of the city at the gate.

16 The father of the young woman shall say to the elders: "I gave my daughter in marriage to this man but he dislikes her;

17 now he has made up charges against her, saying, 'I did not find evidence of your daughter's virginity.' But here is the evidence of my daughter's virginity." Then they shall spread out the cloth before the elders of the town.

18 The elders of that town shall take the

man and punish him;

19 they shall fine him one hundred shekels of silver (which they shall give to the young woman's father) because he has slandered a virgin of Israel. She shall remain his wife; he shall not be permitted to divorce her as long as he lives.

Laura writes:

I believe you have missed the whole point of Deuteronomy 22:13-19. These scriptures are dealing with a man who got married, had sex with her and then wanted to get rid of her because he hated her. In other words he was trying to get out of the marriage by lying about and slandering his new wife.

When his wife's parents were able to show the proof of her virginity, the husband was penalized in two ways. First he was to pay money to his wife's parents and second he was not allowed to ever divorce his wife. These scriptures say nothing whatsoever about his wife not being able to divorce this man.

The wife was not penalized for her husbands breaking of the law. These scriptures clearly show the husband in this case was in the wrong and would not be allowed to divorce because of his lying and slandering.

Phillip writes:

NRSV DEUTERONOMY 22:28 If a man meets a virgin who is not engaged, and seizes her and lies with her, and they are caught in the act,

29 the man who lay with her shall give fifty shekels of silver to the young woman's father, and she shall become his wife. Because he violated her he shall not be permitted to divorce her as long as he lives.

Laura writes:

Here we have a man who did not ask first if he could marry this virgin. Instead he just had sex with her and then they apparently were caught having sexual relations.

Because the woman was a virgin and because they were caught in the act of sex, which shows she is no longer a virgin, the man is responsible for this situation.

The man is now responsible to pay the dowry to the woman's father and to keep her for his wife. His penalty is that he will not be allowed to divorce her because he has taken away her virginity.

Again, the woman was not penalized in this situation. It does not say in these verses that she is not allowed to divorce this man.

The prophets: NRSV MALACHI 2:13 THE

COVENANT PROFANED BY JUDAH

13 And this you do as well: You cover the LORD's altar with tears, with weeping and groaning because he no longer regards the offering or accepts it with favor at your hand.

14 You ask, "Why does he not?" Because the LORD was a witness between you and the wife of your youth, to whom you have been **faithless**, though she is your companion and your wife by covenant.

15 Did not one God make her? Both flesh and spirit are his. And what does the one God desire? Godly offspring. So look to yourselves, and do not let anyone be faithless to the wife of his youth.

16 For I hate divorce, says the LORD, the God of Israel, and covering one's garment with violence, says the LORD of hosts. So take heed to yourselves and do not be faithless.

Laura writes:

In the above verses the word **faithless** is the word **treacherously.** Essentially what is being said in the above scriptures is that God is not accepting your offerings on His alter because man is dealing treacherously with the wife of his youth.

Malachi 2:14 Yet ye say, Wherefore? Because the Lord hath been witness between thee and the wife of thy youth, whom thou hast dealt yet treacherously: is companion, and the wife of thy covenant. Malachi 2:15 And did not he make one? Yet had he the residue of the spirit. And wherefore one? That he might seek a godly seed. Therefore take heed to your spirit, and let none deal treacherously against the wife of his youth.

Malachi 2:16 For the Lord, the God of Israel, saith that he hateth putting away: for one covereth violence with his garment, saith the Lord of hosts: therefore take heed to your spirit, that ye deal not **treacherously**.

Strong's #898--treacherously bagad (baw-gad')

- 1. To act treacherously, deceitfully, deal treacherously,
- a. to act or deal treacherously, faithlessly, deceitfully, offend

So what is clearly being said here is: Men do not deal treacherously with the wife of your youth (verse 15) and in verse 16 God tells you why He doesn't want you men to deal treacherously with the wife of your youth. It is because God hates divorce.

All issues of this newsletter are now posted on our web site. We have published many articles on the issue of Passover and Pentecost.

This letter is in regard to Question #13, which appeared in Issue #22 on page 8.

Paul writes:

I must take issue with your answer about all sins being equal. In Torah there commandments. statutes judgments. There are different penalties for different "sins", even of the same nature. For instance different sexual sins have different penalties. J'shua when he was on trial said to Pilate, he who has handed me over to you has committed the "greater sin". The scriptures are full of references on how God judges different sins in different ways. We do that in natural. A parking ticket does not have the same sentence as murder. So it is in the spiritual. J'shua says it will be lighter in the day of Judgment against Sodom than it will be for those that rejected Him. Not all sins deserve death. All men deserve death because we are sinners not because we sin. There is a difference. To be saved, born again, to be reconciled to God, we must accept the atonement of Messiah for our complete and total rebellion against him. We have been taught by the "Church" that all sins are equal. I submit this is another false teaching which we should reject. 

PERSECUTION OF THOMAS **CRANMER**

************ The history of England in the 1500's and 1600's shows how the heavy hand of the standard religion of Rome was being weakened as more of the population was given access to the Bible in the English language. In 1536 William Tyndale, early translator of the Bible into English, was burned at the stake and choked with a wire at the same time. His last words were, "Lord, open the King of England's eyes."

It is ironic that the vehicle through which England began to become Protestant was through King Henry's desire to continually divorce and re-marry.

Thomas Cranmer took advantage of King Henry's desire to marry Anne Boleyn (Bullock). This plus the heavy hand of the standard religion of Rome paved the way for the establishment of the Church of England. During the outbreak of "sweating sickness" in 1529, Cranmer went to Waltham, Exxex where King Henry was. Henry overheard Cranmer mention to his secretary, Thomas Cromwell, that if the university theologians agreed that Henry's marriage to Catherine of Aragon was illegal, then any ecclesiastical court would grant him a divorce. In response to this King Henry said, "This man I trow, has got the right sow by the ear."

King Henry made Cranmer the archbishop of Canterbury. And Henry married Ann Boleyn on Thursday before the feast of Pentecost in 1533.

Before his death, Tyndale had given all his unpublished translations of the books of the Bible to John Rogers. John Rogers compiled a complete Bible composed mostly from the translations of William Tyndale. It was called the Matthew Bible because Rogers didn't want to put his name on it. The Bible was still a forbidden book in England. King Henry's reaction to the Bible was projected as being unpredictable.

Cranmer examined the Bible and asked Thomas Cromwell to submit it to King Henry for approval. Cromwell presented the Bible to King Henry. King Henry thumbed through the Bible. Rogers had written the initials WT (standing for William Tyndale) after the book of Malachi between the Old and New Testaments. The initials were a quarter of a page high. If Henry noticed the initials he didn't comment on them. King Henry said he approved of the Matthew Bible if Cranmer approved! Cranmer, of course, approved. It became England's first Authorized Version, title page declaring, "by the King's most gracious license."

After the death of King Henry, Bloody Mary eventually came to power as Queen of England and temporarily re-established the link with the standard religion of Rome. She decreed that public use of scripture was forbidden. Once again the Bible became a forbidden book in England. Christians who were able to travel. left England and headed for various cournties in Europe, especially Switzerland. At the beginning of the blood bath, Bloody Mary had the authorities round up her enemies. She had Cranmer tried by a Papal court. At age 67 he was stripped of his title. The bully boys were able to intimidate Cranmer to the extent that he wrote 2 recantations. However, Queen Mary was not satisfied. In his position as archbishop of Canterbury, he was second only to the Monarch of England. So she insisted that he make his recantations known in a public speech. On the day of his address to the crowd, he shocked them by recanting recantations, noting that when they burned him at the stake he would be sure that his right hand would burn first (because it was the one with which he wrote the recantations).

On March 21, 1556, Cranmer was burned at the stake. As promised, he held his right hand out so it would burn first, saying, "This hath offended!" He pulled his hand back only once to wipe his face and then retunred it to the flames. As he was dying he said, "Lord Jesus receive my spirit."

After Bloody Mary died, her step-sister, Elizabeth became Queen of England. Queen Elizabeth crushed the powers loval to the Pope and restored the Bible as a legal book in England.

Laura writes:

I agree with you, it should have been settled locally in Port Austin, Michigan, however. Homer Kizer did not see it that way. The whole matter went public when Homer Kizer chose to post an open letter to Dixon Cartwright on his web site at: http://www.homerkizer.org/cartwright.ht ml In the open letter Homer Kizer slandered a brother Norman Edwards and his wife Marleen Edwards.

Once something goes public in the case of a brother in the church being slandered, then a defense must also be posted publicly in order to reduce and delete the rumors that will grow from a one sided slanderous attack.

In this case Royce Mitchell asked Homer Kizer to give him the evidence for what he posted on his web site. Royce went over the evidence from a legal stand point and found there was no evidence to support

the accusations that Homer Kizer posted on his web site.

Your letter reflects how many people feel in cases such as this and that is why I am printing it here. It is clear from your letter that you neither want to hear the matter nor do you want to become involved in the matter. The Reasonable Conclusions Derived from the Evidence **Delivered** KizerlFrankford/Edwards Fiasco

Here are the facts and conclusions taken from the documents sent to me:

On April 5, 2004, Norm Edwards, Phil Frankford, Paul Drieman and T M Williams came together to create several entities. They were known as the "Port Austin Sabbatarian Church Community" ministry) and the "Port Austin Sabbatarian Community Church" (the church). The goal was to create yet a third entity "Port Austin Sabbatarian Church Community, a Sacred Purpose Trust" (the Trust).

It is important to note that all of these three entities were discussed by their acronyms, PASCC. No doubt this caused confusion among the parties as to which were doing what. Nobody apparently sought any legal counsel prior to preparing such a confusing set of documents.

FOUR TRUSTEES INTENDED

It appears at the beginning that the parties intended to all be trustees on The Trust, while working within the Church and the Ministry which were also being set up. There does not seem to be any written rules in these documents as to who would be responsible or what would happen if there were disagreements between trustees, with the exception that Holy Scripture would provide the rules. This is not a bad idea, but as will be seen, belief in those scriptures as rules did not prevent some who would abuse those scriptures from causing division.

The original trust documents indicate that all four men were to be included as

trustees. Apparently, sometime between that April signing and September 9, 2004, it became clear that Edwards felt as if he was not going to be able to work with the other three men. On April 29, 2004, the original land contract was signed for the property in question, related to the Port Austin Community. Then, in September, the land contract was modified to correct errors made on the earlier land contract. There does not appear to be any fraud in this but merely a correction of an error in the earlier land contract, as is clearly stated in the second contract.

TWO LAND CONTRACTS

What was the problem to be corrected? The four signatories signed as "trustees" of The Trust. The problem was that there WAS no trust at that point. None of the four could legally sign for the trust because the trust did not yet legally exist. On September 9, 2004, the land contract was signed by one trustee, Edwards.

ONE TRUSTEE CHOSEN

At around the same time The Trust document was filed with the clerk's office listing Edwards as the sole trustee. That Trust was created by one Peter Kershaw, who is listed as the Creator. As an aside, only the Creator can name the original trustee or trustees in a trust.

There is evidence that there was at least one meeting held concerning the trusteeships between the parties where it became clear to all other parties that Kershaw had not made anvone but Edwards a trustee. When these meetings did not end with a result that pleased Frankford, and apparently the others (although they have not forwarded any documents or statements on this matter), then a meeting was held on October 31, 2004, for the purpose of dissolving The Church and The Ministry. They could not, of course, dissolve The Trust because they were not empowered by the Trust Creator to do anything.

FRANKFORD, AND **WILLIAMS** DRIEMAN DISSOLVE MINISTRY AND CHURCH

The meeting of October 31, 2004, indicates that the three other men in this matter, Frankford, Williams and Drieman, made a decision to separate themselves from Edwards, and his wife, in a meeting held for the purpose of dissolution of the Church and the Ministry. In that meeting, they order Edwards to no longer use the acronym "PASCC." It is unclear what authority that the board members believed that they had to order such. No evidence of any copyrighting of the acronym was presented by any of the parties. However, it is noted that Edwards did in fact cease to use the acronym in favor of "PASCCSPT" at their request.

KIZER INVOLVED HIMSELF WITHOUT **STANDING TO DO SO**

On October 29, 2004, Homer Kizer, whose position in all of this is unclear, and who apparently took it upon himself to publish the comments related to Edwards. elected to post publicly on his website at: homerkizer.org a defamatory letter related to Edwards. That "Open Letter" laid accusations of fraud, hoax and improper attention to a woman not his wife against Edwards. The letter did not pretend to include any evidence of the author's claims.

On November 4, 2004, I saw that web page as indicated in the earlier posts put on kizer-frankfort website. I contacted Kizer to let him know that I believed his web page to be defamatory. Instead of Kizer responding, I was approached via email by Frankford, with his own "witnesses" for the purpose of making this matter his issue. The rest of the facts are reasonably deducible from the facts and documents delivered and posted on the www.kizer-frankfort.4t.com web page.

Kizer, because he refused to take down his open letter, was asked as a result of his public defamatory remarks to produce the evidence he had against the brother, Edwards. To date, despite being asked many times to either produce the evidence. Kizer has not produced one bit of evidence of any of the accusations made on Kizer's public web page. I asked once again publicly for that evidence based upon the Step 3 procedure by which this action was taken to the Church. I was again refused and instead given Kizer's latest defamatory letter, discussed below.

EDWARDS RESPONDS TO **ACCUSATIONS**

Edwards has responded with a set of reasons he could not work with Frankford. I am including that unedited at the end of this document under the title, "Phillip Daniel Frankford not acceptable as Trustee." Having read through this document, what I find is that Edwards found that Frankford supported the accusatory, divisive writings of Homer Kizer which preceded those I found on the internet at Kizer's website. Those accusatory writings, according to Edwards, made it impossible to work with Frankford. There has been nothing posted to date to refute that assertion and so I believe it to be true.

WILLIAMS? **ACCUSATION** OF **ILLEGALITY**

Edwards posted to me a copy of an email sent to him from Terry Williams which suggested that Edwards was taking part in some sort of scam to defraud the government of taxes. That series of communications is listed below under the title "Williams Frankford Email of August 4, 2004." Edwards answers that email in context. The statement does indeed seem to indicate that Williams believes that what Edwards is doing might be illegal, but no evidence of any illegality is found or evidenced in Williams' writings.

Reading Williams' concerns as voiced to Frankford, it appears to me that Williams gets his law from the whisperings of the neighbors, and not from anyone qualified to understand, much less give an opinion as to the legality of avoiding taxes as much as possible. I find that there is nothing illegal in tax avoidance. Tax evasion is illegal but nothing in the email suggests that Edwards was desirous of evading any taxes but of avoiding legally all taxes that were not due. This, as stated by many a noble statesman since our country began, is the duty of a citizen.

KIZER AND FRANKFORD AGAIN DEFAME EDWARDS

On December 19, 2004, Phillip Frankford posted to the Likeminds Internet Forum a letter written by Homer Kizer apparently on that day in which Kizer brings up yet another instance of a supposed fraud by Edwards. That document is included below under the title, "An Open Letter Concerning Norman Scott Edwards."

Kizer accuses Edwards of pocketing and selling Kizer a house he did not own. This was Kizer's sole contribution in support of the defamatory writings on his webpage. Edwards' response is included below Kizer's open letter. That response is entitled, "An Open Letter Concerning Norman Scott Edwards, An Accusation of Deceit With Response from Edwards." Both writings are incorporated under their names and are unedited.

What Kizer submitted in his report is a "receipt for a down payment." I see nothing more than that in the document. I see nothing that says that Edwards owned the house and in fact see where it is specifically stated that the deposit is taken with a proviso that the tax issue be settled.

As an aside, it happens all of the time that people sell things that they don't own, and then go out and get the items to fill the orders. There is nothing illegal in this, despite Kizer's claims. The illegality, had there been any, would have been if Edwards took the money with no intent of ever delivering the property or of returning

the monies paid for that property or if there was never any possibility of Edwards producing the object of the sale. This is NOT the case in this matter.

Kizer has once again accused a brother of sin and refused to support his accusation with any evidence. This is the same issue of which I earnestly requested Kizer's and Frankfort's repentance. But, I will return to this.

RECEIPT IS A DOWN PAYMENT, NOT A BILL OF SALE

What is seen in the receipt is that Edwards took money as a down payment. A down payment is not a sale. The handwritten receipt is not a contract for sale of real property but a receipt for a down payment on a possible sale. This is VERY common in real estate. It certainly is not fraud to conduct one's self in this manner. The down payment assured that IF Edwards got title to the property as it was supposed to happen (had not Kizer offended the actual owners who thereafter refused to sell to Kizer), then Kizer would be the purchaser from Edwards, who could not resell the house to anyone else without the agreement of Kizer with an additional consideration for his first position to purchase.

DOWN PAYMENT RETURNED BECAUSE OWNER IS NOT INTERESTED IN SELLING TO KIZER

Next, in Edwards' closing comments, it is clear that the money given in down payment is being returned due to the documents posted by Kizer showing that the actual owner has refused to deal with Kizer. This closes the last of that matter and clearly indicates that there was no fraud in the way the house matter was conducted.

ALL MONIES AND EXPENSES INCURRED BY PARTIES TO BE REIMBURSED BY TRUST

There is the matter of the money put into the trust on the part of Williams. In Edwards' "Summary of Events at Port Austin" which is also included below, Edwards has stated for the public record that all monies and expenses incurred by the three other parties will be reimbursed in full.

REASONABLE FINDINGS OF FACTS NO FRAUD BY EDWARDS

What can be reasonably found from the evidence? Do I find any fraud on the part of Norm Edwards? No, I find none.

I find that these four men got together without really knowing each others' intents and found themselves unable to agree on how to do what was to be done, or even to

agree on what was to be done in furtherance of the stated goals of the two men who originated the idea.

EDWARDS ATTEMPTED TO EXPLAIN WHAT HAPPENED

It is clear that Edwards met with the men in an attempt to explain why the Grantor of the Trust decided to include only Edwards as trustee. The facts show that the other three walked out without attempting to get an explanation. Instead, they conducted a psuedo Matthew 18 procedure in which they claimed to be the Church and then conducted a Matthew 18 hearing in absentia (for which no provision is made in scripture) with themselves as the Church wherein they agreed to sever all relationship with Edwards, and his wife. To this date, it is unknown why Mrs. Edwards was selected for their abuse.

MATTHEW 18 ABUSED

It is clear that no "church" hearing was conducted by the parties. Matthew 18 does not mean that the parties to the matter call themselves a church and then go out to beat up on another brother or sister. Yet, that is exactly what the three men did in the name of Christ.

It is certainly true that they should have gone to that brother privately, and some evidence in the form of a statement by Frankford exists that some attempt was made privately to go to Edwards. However, Edwards has rebutted that assertion and stated that the only attempt made was in the meeting in which the other parties walked out without hearing Edwards. This cannot be legitimately called a Matthew 18 procedure.

There is no evidence submitted to date that shows that any attempt to take neutral parties from the Church in order to witness the exchange between brothers was done as is provided for in the Second Step of Matthew 18.

From that point, the parties, as led by Frankford, have apparently supported the public defamation of Edwards. I therefore can only find that Matthew 18 was not done and that what little was done was an abuse of Matthew 18 for the purpose of demeaning and attacking a brother. Whatever was done, according to the evidence in hand, was an abuse of Matthew 18, not done in love but in spite in an attempt to force a brother to comply or destroy what that brother is doing in vengeance.

OTHER FACTS REASONABLY DEDUCIBLE

What I see is four men who apparently did not get legal advice on how

to structure what they wanted to do and who could not put aside their egos long enough to serve the brethren around them--or the God they claim to serve.

It is clear from the evidence that at least one of those four stirred up dissension in that group. It is clear from the evidence that none of the men understood the complexities of the arrangements they had attempted. That is easily seen from their naming the entities such that the acronyms were identical. confusion led tο misunderstanding as to the purpose of the effort. This misunderstanding of the purpose led to a strained relationship between the men, which led to the Grantor causing only Edwards to be appointed Trustee.

It appears from the evidence that the end result was hard feelings leading to recriminations, the recriminations leading from there to the public defamation of Edwards.

CONCLUSION

This matter began over the public posting of defamatory comments by a brother about a brother. This is seen at the www.kizer-frankfort.4t.com website. The accusers were asked to do one of two things, either provide the evidence or cease all further defamatory comments, including taking down the web page.

The defaming brothers, Kizer and Frankford, have steadfastly refused to post the evidence of their claims. Instead, they have taken to defaming me as their defense. What little that has been posted in support of their claims does not support those claims. The actions of Kizer and Frankford have from the beginning of this procedure, and, from the evidence submitted, early on in this activity, been divisive.

Therefore, I see no reason to believe that Kizer or Frankford intend to repent of their sin of publicly defaming a brother (false witness). Although it is my intent by posting this that they will be convinced to see that no illegal or fraudulent activities were intended by anyone in this matter, and therefore repent of those public defamatory accusations, it is my belief that even this public assessing of the matters underlying this set of events will not dissuade them from their sin.

For this reason, it is with a heavy heart that I conclude these brothers in sin and pending repentance consider them as the heathens and publicans Christ asked us to do. I lay the evidence before the brethren in the hopes that they will assist me in moving these men to repent and rejoin the Body of Christ.

As to Drieman and Williams, it is my belief that they had no part of the public defamation of Edwards. It is my belief that Drieman had reasonable concerns about legitimacy of tax strategies and that those should have been clearly explained to Drieman by Edwards or someone who understood those strategies and could convey them in such a way that Drieman could understand them.

As to Edwards, it is my belief that Edwards contributed to this confusion because of his inability to convey his avoidance understanding of versus evasion. He also contributed to this confusion by not conveying his intended actions until he had already done them. It is not sin to change your mind. If it were, all of us would be doomed. It is sin to say one thing while all the while intending something different. There does not appear to be any evidence that Edwards put all of this in motion for the intent of cutting out the other potential trustees and taking anything unlawfully from them. The evidence leads to the conclusion that Edwards changed his mind about having the other three as Trustees based upon misgivings about the ability of the other three to actually conform themselves to the purpose of the Trust. There is no sin in that.

In all cases, it is my opinion based upon the writings of the men involved and the copies of documents forwarded to me that these men did not fully understand what they were getting into, did not understand the law behind the entities they were attempting to put into motion and were not able to conduct themselves in a manner befitting Christian brothers, despite their claim to be desirous of that in their documents.

There was no evidence of fraud. There was confusion; all of the parties are culpable for the confusion.

There was and continues to be defamation. Edwards should, as he has stated he will do, refund all of the money put into the trust by the parties, including reasonable expenses.

Kizer should probably prepare for a defamation suit. Frankford should probably prepare for a defamation suit. These preparations should be considered by the Church as the result of damage done to a brother by a heathen and publican, and not by a brother, because of the refusal to repent of those brothers.

There was no evidence presented of any improper relationship with any woman who is not Edwards' wife.

There was no evidence of any hoax perpetrated on the brethren being submitted to us.

LET YOUR WOMEN KEEP **SILENCE IN THE CHURCHES:**

This has long been a controversy in the Church and in the world, but is it Biblically true or are many people just taking a couple of scriptures and making a doctrine out of them which both hurts the mission of the Church of God and oppresses women at the same time.

Human nature generally tends towards the thinking that because everybody is doing it or everybody believes something it must be right or true. Many people reading this article understand this concept is rarely the case in fact. Is it possible that on this subject matter that the majority could possibly be wrong as well?

We find these scriptures used to oppress women in I Corinthians 14:34-35:

- 34. Let your women keep silence in the churches: for it is not permitted unto them to speak; but they are commanded to be under obedience, as also saith the law.
- 35. And if they will learn any thing, let them ask their husbands at home: for it is a shame for women to speak in the church.

When one first reads over these scriptures, in verse 35 where it says: "if they (women) will learn any thing," it almost sounds as though women are so stupid that it is hard to teach them any thing. Did God create women stupid?

Genesis 1:26 And God said, Let us (God the Father and Christ) make man (Strong's #120, man and woman) in our (God the Father and Christ's) image, after our (God the Father and Christ's) likeness: and let them (man and woman) have

dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and **over all the earth**, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

In Genesis 1:26 we find that both man and woman were created in God's image and that both man and woman equally had dominion over all the earth. There is absolutely no hiarchy spoken of here, showing that any man has control over any woman. It also proves that if women were indeed made stupid, then so to must God be stupid, for God made both man and woman in the image of God himself, as shown again in Genesis 1:27.

27. So God created man (man and woman) in his (God the Father and Christ's) own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them (man and woman). Genesis 1:27

Here's what the law of God says in regard to how men should treat women.

 Whoso sheddeth man's (mans or womans) blood, by man (man or woman) shall his blood be shed: for in the image of God made he man (man and woman).Genesis 9:6

God does not want man or woman to kill other men or women because both men and women are made in the image of God. This again shows that men and women are equal in the sight of God and that there should be no oppression coming from either of the sexes against the other whether it be in abusive words which can lead to physical abuse which can lead to murder. Men and women are equal in God's eyes.

 For a man indeed ought not to cover his head, forasmuch as he is the image and glory of God: but the woman is the glory of the man. 1 Corinthians 11:7

Man is to be the glory (honor or reflection) of God and woman is to be the glory (honor or reflection) of man. In other words Man is to be like God in his character and woman is to then in turn be like her husband as he, her husband reflects God. There is nothing in this verse which even remotely shows that women are to be submissive to men no matter what men might do or order someone to do. This verse simply shows that both men and women are to follow God and that just as God leads the man, then so to does the man lead the woman in the things of God.

- 16. Nevertheless when it (both men and women) shall turn to the Lord, the vail (blindness) shall be taken away.
- 17. Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.
- 18. But we all (men and women), with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even

as by the Spirit of the Lord. 2 Corinthians 3:16-18

Again in the above scriptures there is no hiarchy of men over women shown. Both men and women equally will be changed into the same spiritual image of God by God's Spirit. For those men and women who truly are converted and have God's Holy Spirit working in them there will be no reflection of men oppressing women by the use of scripture twisted into false doctrines.

When men believe that women are not spiritually equal to them in God's eyes, there can be no growth within the Church for there is no love. God's Church only grows and thrives on love.

- 34. A new commandment I give unto you, That **ye love one another**; as I have loved you, that ye also **love one another**.
- 35. By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples (Strong's #3101, follower of Christ), if ye have love one to another. John 13:34-35

There is no gender specific command there only to love men and not women. It says to love all disciples because by your love for one another will you be known to the outside world. If no love reflects from your group then you are not treating all those in your group as equal in spiritual things.

Why does your light not reflect the love of God to the entire world?

 And because iniquity (sin) shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold. Matthew 24:12

How do you believe this happens? If men and women are created spiritually equal in the image of God, and if woman cannot be stupid unless God is stupid, then perhaps it is time for men who believe they are to rule over women, to start looking at how this sin of oppression to women clearly is an abuse in the eyes of God.

When man makes a doctrine based on basically two scriptures from the bible we can for the most part generally find that it will be a false doctrine. A false doctrine is one that cannot be supported with other scriptural proofs from Genesis to Revelation.

When men and it is generally men, continue to promote the doctrine that women are not to speak in the church, they are doing a great disservice to both God and the Church. Essentially what this doctrine teaches is that woman cannot teach, preach, or prophesy in any way shape or form the word of God. Now some men do say it is okay for woman to sing in church and ask questions, but is that what the scripture says which they base their false doctrine on?

34. Let your women keep silence in the

- churches: for it is not permitted unto them to speak; but they are commanded to be under obedience, as also saith the law.
- 35. And if they will learn any thing, let them ask their husbands at home: for it is a shame for women to speak in the church. 1 Corinthians 14:34-35

Let's really disect these two verses. "Let your women keep silence in the churches:" In other words women should keep silent in all churches as the word churches there is plural. "For it is not permitted unto them to speak; but they are commanded to be under obedience, as also saith the law." Now whether one wants to say there is a law in God's law which specifically commands women not to speak or whether you want to say that the law of God commands women only to submit to men, one cannot find either of those laws any where in the law of God. Remember earlier, God's command in Genesis was that both men and women have dominion over the entire earth, Gen. 1:26. And so far no one has been able to find a law of God in the Old Testament which forbids women to speak in any capacity including in church. What we do find from Genesis to Revelation is that women were found doing the work of God, whether it be teaching, prophesying or some other form of discipleship.

Let's continue with: "And if they will learn any thing, let them ask their husbands at home: for it is a shame for women to speak in the church." If we are to take this literally for what it says, this would certainly exclude women from both singing and asking questions, since it clearly says to ask 'whatever' of their husbands at home. It also goes on to say it is a shame for a woman to speak in church. In other words she just plain should not be speaking at all in church and if she is able to learn, learn it from her husband at home. So I would conclude from this that even the men who are promoting this false doctrine, clearly can't read the scripture if they are teaching along with it that women can sing or ask questions in church, because I don't see that written into that command, if indeed it truly is a command of God as false teachers say it is.

Paul Quotes From the Letter He Received From the Corinthians or from the Talmud?

If these two scriptures are not commands of God, then what are they doing here and where did they come from? If one reads the entire chapter of I Corinthians 14, one will find that either Paul is a very confused man or these two scriptures are clearly out of context in

regard to what Paul is saying here. Look at:

31. For **ye may all prophesy one by one**, that all may learn, and **all** may be comforted. 1 Corinthians 14:31

This scripture clearly says all prophesy, both men and women. In order to prophesy, one must speak. That verse clearly comes before verses 34 & 35. Then after Paul tells women to shut up in verses 34 & 35, Paul again tells us in verse 39:

39. Wherefore, brethren (men and women), covet to prophesy, and forbid not to speak with tongues. 1 Corinthians 14:39

So is Paul confused or is there another explanation for verses 34 & 35?

We find a valid explanation for this discrepency in other scriptures, for instance:

- Now concerning the things whereof ye (the Corinthians) wrote unto me (Paul): It is good for a man not to touch a woman. 1 Corinthians 7:1
- In 1 Corinthians we find where Paul is clearly quoting what the Corinthians wrote to him. So might verses 34 & 35 be a quotation from some place else? We also find the below listed scriptures which clearly show that Paul was writing to the Corinthians in regard to things that were wrong in their church.
 - 1 Corinthians 4:14 **I write** not these things to shame you, but as my beloved sons I warn you.
 - 1 Corinthians 5:9 **I wrote** unto you in an epistle not to company with fornicators:
 - 1 Corinthians 14:37 If any man think himself to be a prophet, or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things that **I** write unto you are the commandments of the Lord.
 - 2 Corinthians 1:13 For **we write** none other things unto you, than what ye read or acknowledge; and I trust ye shall acknowledge even to the end;
 - 2 Corinthians 2:3 And I wrote this same unto you, lest, when I came, I should have sorrow from them of whom I ought to rejoice; having confidence in you all, that my joy is the joy of you all.
 - 2 Corinthians 2:4 For out of much affliction and anguish of heart **I wrote** unto you with many tears; not that ye should be grieved, but that ye might know the love which I have more abundantly unto you.
 - 2 Corinthians 2:9 For to this end also did **I write**, that I might know the proof of you, whether ye be obedient in all things. 2 Corinthians 7:12 Wherefore, though **I wrote** unto you, I did it not for his cause that had done the wrong, nor for his cause that suffered wrong, but that our care for you in the sight of God might

appear unto you.

- 2 Corinthians 9:1 For as touching the ministering to the saints, it is superfluous for me **to write** to you:
- 2 Corinthians 13:2 I told you before, and foretell you, as if I were present, the second time; and being absent now I write to them which heretofore have sinned, and to all other, that, if I come again, I will not spare:
- 2 Corinthians 13:10 Therefore I write these things being absent, lest being present I should use sharpness, according to the power which the Lord hath given me to edification, and not to destruction.

We also can tell from scripture that Paul having been a Pharisee who was responsible for killing those with in the Church of God knew full well what the "oral law of the Jews" said.

- 13. For ye have heard of my conversation in time past in the Jews' religion, how that beyond measure I persecuted the church of God, and wasted it:
- 14. And profited in the Jews' religion above many my equals in mine own nation, being more exceedingly zealous of the traditions of my fathers (for example the Talmud). Galatians 1:13-14

In other words, Paul was persecuting the Church of God because he was following the "traditions of his fathers". The Jews' religion referred to here is the law of the Jews or what is referred to as the "Jewish Oral Law" which has been since written down and is included in the Talmud and other books which the Jewish people hold in high esteem. This "Jewish Oral Law" was exactly what Christ was blasting them for in Matthew Chapter 23. The Pharisees and Scribes were binding heavy burdens on the people which were clearly not written within the law of God. This "Jewish Oral Law" is not nor never was the word of God and contained within the "Jewish Oral Law" are many things which are clearly against the law of God or which were meant to control others.

In the below verses, one can clearly see that Christ did not go along with the Jews "tradition of the elders," because it was in many cases the opposite of what God's law said or commanded of us.

- Why do thy disciples transgress the tradition of the elders? for they wash not their hands when they eat bread.
- But he answered and said unto them, Why do ye also transgress the commandment of God by your tradition? Matthew 15:2-3
- For the Pharisees, and all the Jews, except they wash their hands oft, eat

- not, holding the tradition of the elders. Mark 7:3
- And when they come from the market, except they wash, they eat not. And many other things there be, which they have received to hold, as the washing of cups, and pots, brasen vessels, and of tables.
- 5. Then the Pharisees and scribes asked him, Why walk not thy disciples according to the tradition of the elders, but eat bread with unwashen hands?
- For laying aside the commandment of God, ye hold the tradition of men, as the washing of pots and cups: and many other such like things ye do.
- And he said unto them, Full well ye reject the commandment of God, that ye may keep your own tradition. Mark 7:3-9
- And honour not his father or his mother, he shall be free. Thus have ye made the commandment of God of none effect by your tradition. Matthew 15:6
- 13. Making the word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye. Mark 7:13

The Jewish oral law taught people not to honor their fathers and mothers, among many other things which clearly were against the Law of God and which Christ in no way ever went along with as we can see from the above scriptures.

8. Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ. Colossians 2:8

So with the above warning in mind, we must be sure that what we teach to others is of God or whether it is from the tradition of men, or in other words, things which men make up and teach in order to control other people in some way.

Women Leaders in the Bible

Whether I Corinthians 14:34-35 was a quote from a letter that the Corithians wrote to Paul or Paul was quoting it from the Talmud or some other part of the "Jewish Oral Law," it doesn't really matter, because it can be proven beyond a shadow of a doubt that many scriptures from Genesis to Revelation show women doing the same spiritual things that men have long claimed is only exclusive to them. Let's look at some of them:

Miriam

We find Miriam leading other women in

songs, music and dance.

- 20. And Miriam the prophetess, the sister of Aaron, took a timbrel in her hand; and all the women went out after her with timbrels and with dances.
- 21. And Miriam answered them, Sing ye to the Lord, for he hath triumphed gloriously; the horse and his rider hath he thrown into the sea. Exodus 15:20-21

Huldah

We find the king consulting Huldah for her knowledge in regard to the law of God.

- 13. Go ye, inquire of the Lord for me, and for the people, and for all Judah, concerning the words of this book that is found: for great is the wrath of the Lord that is kindled against us, because our fathers have not hearkened unto the words of this book, to do according unto all that which is written concerning us.
- 14. So Hilkiah the priest, and Ahikam, and Achbor, and Shaphan, and Asahiah, went unto **Huldah the prophetess**, the wife of Shallum the son of Tikvah, the son of Harhas, keeper of the wardrobe; (now she dwelt in Jerusalem in the college;) and they communed with her.
- 15. And she said unto them, Thus saith the Lord God of Israel, Tell the man that sent you to me,
- 16. Thus saith the Lord, Behold, I will bring evil upon this place, and upon the inhabitants thereof, even all the words of the book which the king of Judah hath read:
- 17. Because they have forsaken me, and have burned incense unto other gods, that they might provoke me to anger with all the works of their hands; therefore my wrath shall be kindled against this place, and shall not be quenched.
- 18. But to the king of Judah which sent you to inquire of the Lord, Thus shall ye say to him, Thus saith the Lord God of Israel, As touching the words which thou hast heard:
- 19. Because thine heart was tender, and thou hast humbled thyself before the Lord, when thou heardest what I spake against this place, and against the inhabitants thereof, that they should become a desolation and a curse, and hast rent thy clothes, and wept before me; I also have heard thee, saith the Lord.
- 20. Behold therefore, I will gather thee unto thy fathers, and thou shalt be gathered into thy grave in peace; and thine eyes shall not see all the evil which I will bring upon this place. And they brought the king word again. 2 Kings 22:13-20 (See also 2 Chronicles 34:21-28)

Anna

We find Anna speaking in regard to Christ, to all who looked for redemption in Jerusalem.

- 36. And there was one **Anna**, a prophetess, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Aser: she was of a great age, and had lived with an husband seven years from her virginity;
- 37. And she was a widow of about fourscore and four years, which departed not from the temple, but served God with fastings and prayers night and day.
- 38. And she coming in that instant gave thanks likewise unto the Lord, and spake of him (Christ) to all them that looked for redemption in Jerusalem. Luke 2:36-37

Phebe

We find Phebe in charge of the church at Cenchrea and Paul is telling others to assist her in the business of the church as she needs

- I commend unto you Phebe our sister, which is a servant (minister/deacon See Strong's #1249) of the church which is at Cenchrea:
- That ye receive her in the Lord, as becometh saints, and that ye assist her in whatsoever business she hath need of you: for she hath been a succourer (a woman set over others See Strong's #4368) of many, and of myself (Paul) also. Romans 16:1-2

Deborah

We find that Deborah was a judge who judged matters of both men and women as the law of God stated. Deborah was definitely a woman who corrected both men and women when correction according to the law of God was needed.

- 4. And **Deborah**, a prophetess, the wife of Lapidoth, she judged Israel (both men and women) at that time.
- And she dwelt under the palm tree of Deborah between Ramah and Bethel in mount Ephraim: and the children of Israel (both men and women) came up to her for judgment. Judges 4:4-5

A MATTER OF FAITH

 Let us therefore fear, lest, a promise being left us of entering into his rest, any of you should seem to come short of it.

 For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard it. Hebrews 4:1-2

Preconceived ideas hinder understanding of God's teachings. Just as the disciples had preconceived that Christ would restore the kingdom right then, that clouded their mind so that they did not understand that Christ came to fulfill the words of God, what had been written of Him, including that He must be the Lamb of God without blemish, and give himself as our sacrifice. (Mark 9:31-32 Luke 24:44-46) They thought they could prove that Christ would restore the kingdom right then by scripture. Even if many had taught that error, that did not make it the truth. We have a preconceived idea; THAT CHRIST COULD HAVE SINNED. Which no one argues, would have scrapped God's plan. This leads us and others to doubt God's promises, to relegate them to "good intentions" and God to a state of weakness. And causes us to miss MUCH VALUABLE UNDERSTANDING, and true FAITH.

Another point that should be made: When Martin Luther "came out of the Catholic church" he and many that followed (Anglican, Baptist, Presbyterian, etc.) still held to many of their teachings. How much have we "come out"? Are we still tenaciously holding on to many of the errors that we've been taught? Do we still believe all we were taught was the plain truth?

To clear up this preconceived idea we need to answer three very important questions:

- 1. Did God promise that Christ would (not could) be our savior?
- 2. Was Christ's sacrifice absolutely necessary?
- 3. Can we believe God?

You might ask, why are these questions important? The answer concerns our FAITH in God, our excellent knowledge of Christ, whether we represent God and Christ properly to others, and whether we build up the FAITH of others or tear it down.

13. Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ:



Ephesians 4:13

If God declared without a doubt that Christ must fulfill the roll of "the lamb of God", to be a sinless sacrifice in order to make it possible for us, and those before us, and after us, to have hope of eternal life; then if Christ had sinned, God's words were not 100% sure, and where would that place His other promises?

It might be thought to be a small matter, to us, after the fact, but, can you imagine Abraham telling Isaac that Christ could sin, but probably wouldn't, the odds were certainly in his favor, but... Or asking Christ: "Do you think You will be able to do it?"

23. And the scripture was fulfilled which says, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God. James 2:23

We are warned to discern false prophets and reject them, and that they would come. Matthew 7:15 Matthew 24:4-5 Revelation 2:2

One of the false teachings we are warned of is a teaching of another Christ, and/or another gospel.

- 6. I marvel that you are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto another gospel:
- 7. Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ. Galatians 1:6-7
- 22. Who is a liar but he that denieth that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son. 1 John 2:22

The basis we are to judge by is God's word, not what some man/men have taught us. Romans 10:17 1 Corinthians 2:5 John 17:17 Matthew 15:8-9

We must be cleansed of our preconceived ideas so that we can understand God's teachings. We have been taught that Christ was human, and because He was human, He could have sinned, and by that sin lose His eternal life. And because we would not have a sacrifice to wash away our sins, to atone for us, we, and all those before, would be lost, thereby thwarting God's promises.

- 17. And if Christ be not raised, your faith [is] vain; you are yet in your sins.
- 18. Then they also which are fallen asleep in Christ are perished.
- 19. If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most miserable. 1 Corinthians 15:17-19

That teaching makes God out to be a well meaning but weak do-gooder, unable to fulfill His promises, because they were dependent on a necessary but unreliable second party. Isn't that exactly what Satan would want us to believe, that we can not

believe God?

- 17. But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, you shall not eat of it: for in the day that you eat thereof you shall surely die. Genesis 2:17
- 4. And the serpent said unto the woman, You shall not surely die: Genesis 3:4
 But is that what God's word says?
- 17. Wherein God, willing more abundantly to show unto the heirs of promise the immutability of his counsel, confirmed [it] by an oath:
- 18. That by two immutable things, in which [it was] impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us:
- 19. Which [hope] we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast, and which enters into that within the veil; Hebrews 6:17-19
- 22. Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.
- 23. Let us hold fast the profession of [our] faith without wavering; (for he [is] faithful that promised:) Hebrews 10:22-23

Does not God's word say that there is nothing too hard for Him? I know (somewhat) how hard this is to accept. Abraham did not learn this right away, but he did, and became the father of the faithful

- 14. Is any thing too hard for the LORD? At the time appointed I will return unto thee, according to the time of life, and Sarah shall have a son. Genesis 18:14
- 17. Ah Lord GOD! behold, you have made the heaven and the earth by your great power and stretched out arm, [and] there is nothing too hard for thee: Jeremiah 32:17
- 26. Then came the word of the LORD unto Jeremiah, saying,
- 27. Behold, I [am] the LORD, the God of all flesh: is there any thing too hard for me? Jeremiah 32:26-27

Did he not also believe that what God promises He will do?

- 2. In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began; Titus 1:2
- 55. Yet you have not known him; but I know him: and if I should say, I know him not, I shall be a liar like unto you: but I know him, and keep his saying.
- 56. Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day: and he saw [it], and was glad. John 8:55-56

Abraham knew of Christ's sacrifice, it

was 100% sure to him, as if it had already been accomplished. Why, because God had said it. 1 Peter 1:18-21.

If we do not believe that God keeps His promises, and can fulfill them, then we are of all men most miserable having only a hope of a hope, not much more than a dream, not the FAITH of hope, that we need to endure.

19. If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most miserable. 1 Corinthians 15:19


