The "National Animal Identification System": A New Threat to Rural Freedom

Small farmers and homesteaders have chosen their way of life because they love their freedom - the freedom from urban noise and congestion, the independence from government and corporate interference, the self-reliance of providing one's own shelter, water, food. Now the USDA's NAIS - National Animal Identification System - threatens the traditional freedoms of the rural way of life.

The genesis of the NAIS

The NAIS is the brainchild of the National Institute for Animal Agriculture (NIAA). Who is the NIAA? Primarily two groups;

- the biggest corporate players in U.S. meat production (for example, the National Pork Producers, Monsanto, Cargill Meat); and
- the makers and marketers of high-tech animal ID equipment (for example, Digital Angel, Inc., EZ-ID/AVID ID Systems, Micro Beef Technologies, Ltd.).

Beginning in 2002, the NIAA used 9/11, and subsequently the BSE scares to lobby the USDA for a nationwide, all-livestock registration and tracking system. The result is the USDA's proposed NAIS, set forth in a Draft Strategic Plan (Plan), and Draft Program Standards (Standards), released on April 25, 2005. The Plan and Standards can be downloaded from www.usda.gov/nais.

Main requirements of the NAIS

The NAIS would require two types of mandatory registration. First, premises registration would require every person who owns even one horse, cow, pig, chicken, sheep, pigeon, or virtually any livestock animal, to register their home, including owner's name, address, and telephone number, and keyed to Global Positioning System coordinates (for satellite-assisted location of homes and farms), in a federal database under a 7-digit "premises ID number." (Standards, pp. 3-4, 10-12; Plan, p. 5.)

Second, individual animal identification will require owners to obtain a 15-digit ID number, also to be kept in the federal database, for any animal that ever leaves the premises of its birth. Thus, even if you are raising animals only for your own food, you will have to obtain an individual ID to send animals to a slaughterhouse, to sell or buy animals, to obtain stud service. (Large-scale producers will be allowed to identify, e.g., large groups of pigs or broilers raised and processed together by a single group ID number. However, owners raising single animals or a small number, under most circumstances, will have to identify each animal individually for purposes of slaughter, sale, or breeding.) If you own a non-food animal such as a horse, you would need individual ID if you ever left your property for shows or trail rides. The form of ID will most likely be a tag or microchip containing a Radio Frequency Identification Device, designed to be read from a distance. (Plan, p. 10; Standards, pp. 6, 12, 20, 27-28.) In addition to this "electronic identification," the USDA will allow "industry" to decide whether to require the use of "retinal scan" and "DNA" identification for all animals. (Plan, p. 13.)

Within this system, for animals subject to individual animal identification, the animal owner would be required to report: the birth date of an animal, the application of every animal's ID tag, every time an animal leaves or enters the property, every time an animal loses a tag, every time a tag is replaced, the slaughter or death of an animal, or if any animal is missing. Such events must be reported within 24 hours. (Standards, pp. 12-13. 17-21.) The USDA plans "enforcement" to ensure compliance with the NAIS. (Standards, p. 7; Plan, p. 17.) The USDA has not yet specified the nature of this "enforcement," but presumably it would include fines and/or seizure of animals.

A more recent development is a movement, spearheaded by the National Cattlemen's Beef Association (NCBA), to "privatize" the database, which will contain all the premises and animal identification information, and tracking information. As reported in *Lancaster Farming*, Aug. 6, 2005, p. E 22, the NCBA has lobbied the House Agriculture Committee to urge the USDA to put the NAIS database administration into the control of the NCBA itself. As explained below, such "privatization" will only worsen the prospects for invasion of privacy, and economic pressures on small farmers and homesteaders.

Any "benefits" of the NAIS Are illusory

The NIAA and USDA claim two principal benefits of the NAIS: first, enhancing export markets for U.S. livestock products; and second, allowing traceback to farms of animals' origin when animal diseases (such as BSE) are found. These "benefits" are of no use to most small farmers and homesteaders. Small farmers and homesteaders sell to their neighbors, or consume their animal products themselves they don't profit from "export markets." Small farmers and homesteaders raise their animals in natural and healthy conditions usually on pasture, with minimal home-raised or organic grain, with plenty of space for exercise and dispersal of waste - to assure that problems like BSE and bacterial contamination won't occur in the home-raised animals destined for their own tables.

Indeed, the NAIS "traceback" system would be much less effective against BSE than a system of testing every slaughtered cow. Europe and Japan perform testing of every cow. The USDA has refused such testing; but surely the testing would be less expensive than a huge tracking system covering every cow, horse, donkey, llama, alpaca, pig, sheep, goat, pigeon, chicken, duck, farmed fish, etc., etc.

Moreover, the NAIS system would be of no use at all in dealing with the most common types of meat contamination in the U.S., the occurrence of pathogens such as listeria or E. coli in processed meat. One example of such contamination can be found at www.fsis.usda.gov/Fsis_recalls, 2005 recalls nos. 033-2005 and 040-2005. Those incidents involved over one million pounds (enough to serve at least four million people) of ground beef contaminated with coliform bacteria, distributed nationwide by a single processor. Such instances of contamination are not discovered until the meat has been distributed into the supply chain.

Assuming that a cow yields 500 pounds of ground meat, the one million pounds in the foregoing recalls represent meat from over 2,000 cows. There is no way to identify individual cows from one million pounds of hamburger; no way to tell if any contamination came from a cow, multiple cows, or from the processing itself; and no benefit to consumer safety in such a situation from the NAIS system. In sum, when meat becomes contaminated at a large packing plant, millions of consumers in all 50 states can be exposed to the dangerous product. In contrast, an incident of impaired food at a small-scale farm or local processor might affect only a few dozen consumers in a single county. Thus, by encouraging increased consolidation of the meat industry, the NAIS would actually make America's food supply more unstable and less safe.

It is therefore clear that the benefits of the NAIS are illusory. Unfortunately, the harms of the NAIS are very real, and fall primarily upon the smallest farmers, homesteaders, and consumers.

The harms of the NAIS are very real

The NAIS will drive small producers out of the market, will prevent people from raising animals for their own food, will invade Americans' personal privacy, and will violate the religious freedom of Americans whose beliefs make it impossible for them to comply.

The NAIS will create an unfair economic burden on small farmers and homesteaders, because animal owners will bear the costs of property and animal registration. As the USDA frankly admits,

"there will be costs to producers" (Plan, p. 11); "private funding will be required... Producers will identify their animals and provide necessary records to the databases... All groups will need to provide labor." (Plan, p. 14.)

In sum, there is no realistic chance of government funding to cover the costs of the program once it is established, and animal owners will have to pay the tab for premises registration fees, individual animal ID fees,

reporting fees for events such as animals leaving a given premises or being slaughtered, and for equipment such as RFID tags, tag readers, or software needed to report to the database. The proposed privatization of the NAIS would only worsen the economic burden, since a private database holder would certainly want to make some profit from the system.

The NAIS would also, in fact, lessen rather than improve - the security of America's animal foods. The NAIS is touted by the USDA and agricorporations as a way to make our food supply "secure" against diseases or terrorism. However, most people instinctively understand that real food security comes from raising food yourself, or buying from a local farmer you actually know. The USDA plan will only stifle local sources of production through over-regulation and additional costs. Ultimately, if the NAIS goes into effect, more consumers will have to buy food produced by the large-scale industrial methods which multiply the effects of any food safety and disease problems. Moreover, the NAIS system will create opportunities for havoc, such as the deliberate introduction of diseased animals into premises containing large numbers of a given species.

Perhaps the most troubling aspect of the NAIS is its proponents' lack of concern for individual privacy and religious freedom. Consider that the NAIS plan is a compulsory registration with the government of all people who want to raise their own animal foods. Concededly, the Bill of Rights does not contain Constitutional amendment а specifically to protect one's right to produce one's own food. But that is only because the generation of the Founders could never have imagined that American government could evolve into a system that would compel citizens to, in effect, ask for government permission to produce their own food.

Further, consider that livestock animals are legally a form of personal property. It is unprecedented for the United States government to conduct large-scale, computer-aided, surveillance of its citizens simply because they own a common type of (The exceptions property. only registration of motor vehicles and guns, due to their clear inherent dangers - but they are registered at the state level, not by the government. Moreover, those registration systems predate the widespread of personal computers and the development of the Internet, so even the car and gun registration systems were never intended as the widespread threat to privacy and freedom that they have become today.) Surveillance of small-scale livestock owners is like the government subjecting people to surveillance for owning a couch, a tv, a lawnmower, or any item of personal property.

Moreover, privatization of the NAIS will surely result in the same gross abuses already evident in private databases of financial information - the sale of citizens' most personal data, without their knowledge, to the highest bidder; and the vulnerability of citizens' information to hackers and thieves, because the President and Congress, have utterly failed to subject the powerful private data industry to long-needed protections for citizens' privacy.

The NAIS also violates America's tradition of respect for the religious freedom of members of minority faith communities. Many adherents of plain, (and other) faiths, raise their own food animals, and use animals in farming and transportation, because their beliefs require them to live this way. Such people obviously cannot comply with the USDA's computerized, technologydependent system; and many of them also believe that scriptural teachings or other religious tenets prohibit the marking of animals or homes with high-tech numbering systems. The NAIS will force these people to violate their religious beliefs, by compelling them to make an impossible choice between abandoning the livestock ownership necessary to their religious way of life, or accepting the government's imposition of practices abhorrent to their faith.

The USDA's planned NAIS timetable

The following is the USDA's timetable. as set forth in the Draft Strategic Plan, and Draft Program Standards, on April 25, 2005, for implementing the mandatory NAIS. Essentially, the USDA timetable would make premises identification and individual animal identification mandatory as of January 1, 2008. Please note that there can be no assurance that the USDA will not advance delay) the previously announced timetable. In addition, the USDA timetable may differ from that of individual states, which have had the incentive of grant money from the USDA to establish pilot projects of premises and animal identification. (For example, Wisconsin is attempting to compel premises and animal identification by late 2005, or during 2006.)

- April 2005 the USDA issued its Draft Strategic Plan and Draft Program Standards for public comment. The public comment period for those documents ended in early July 2005.
- July 2006 the Draft Strategic Plan (p. 10) gives July 2006 as the target date for the USDA to issue a proposed rule setting forth the requirements for NAIS premises registration, animal identification, and animal tracking. This will be a crucial juncture for action by those

who will be harmed by the NAIS, because there will be a limited public comment period after the publication of the rule, and objections expressed in the public comments may persuade the USDA to modify, or abandon some requirements of the rule.

- Fall 2007 the USDA plans to publish a "final rule" to establish the requirements of the mandatory NAIS. (Plan, p. 10.)
- January 2008 this is the most crucial date in the USDA's present timetable, the date when premises identification and animal identification would become mandatory. (Plan, pp. 2, 10.)
- January 2009 "animal tracking" would become mandatory, including "enforcement" of the reporting of animal movements. (Plan, p. 17.)

How to oppose the NAIS

There is still time to oppose mandatory premises and animal identification. Smallscale keepers of livestock can take action to create an effective movement in opposition to the USDA/agricorporate plan. First, smallscale livestock owners should not participate in any so-called "voluntary" state or federal program to register farms or animals. The USDA is using farmers' supposed willingness to enter a "voluntary" program as a justification for making the program mandatory. (See Plan, "Executive Summary" and pp. 7-8.) If a state or extension official urges registration of your premises or livestock, question them about whether the registration is mandatory or voluntary, and about any deadline for registration; and ask them for a copy of the legislation or rule establishing any claimed authority to require such registration.

Small farmers and livestock owners can also help inform and organize others. The USDA presently does not plan to finalize its rules to establish mandatory ID until the summer of 2006. (As stated above, individual states, such as Wisconsin, may be planning earlier implementation, but even in such states, widespread objection by animal owners can still affect whether plans become permanent and whether reasonable exceptions may be established.) Animal owners should contact breed associations. sustainable organic and farming organizations, or general farming interest groups and ask them to oppose the NAIS. Also ask such organizations to start or support campaigns of letter-writing to officials and of commenting on the USDA rules scheduled to be issued in summer 2006 (and any similar state rules).

NAIS opponents can also individually

write their federal and state legislators. You can find contact information for both federal and state officials through www.voteor the through federal smart.org government's site. www.firstgov.gov. Remember, the conventional wisdom is that individual letters sent by postal mail carry more weight than e-mails, or signing on to form letters. But any input is more useful than no input, so if you don't have time for an individual letter, use e-mail, telephone, group petitions, or any means you can. Also remember that both individual initiative and group initiatives count, so even after you have sent a letter, continue, if you can, to respond to calls for action asking you to send additional messages to government officials.

In particular, the USDA's planned issuance of a NAIS rule for public comment in July 2006, will be a crucial juncture. Be aware of press coverage or action alerts at that time, and when you hear that the public comment period on a NAIS rule is open, please take the time to submit an individual comment.

Finally, if the time comes when the NAIS, or a state equivalent, is about to go into effect as presently planned, and you feel your rights are being violated, you can contact groups that may provide legal representation without cost. Some sources of information to try are:

they were killed they were prepared (which took some time) to be eaten, naturally, that evening - which began the 15th and the FEAST OF UNLEAVENED BREAD. Nothing of the Passover lamb was to be left over until the morning (Ex. 12:8-10).

God decreed that only unleavened bread should be eaten with the Passover lamb, and that only unleavened bread should be found throughout our property for seven days: "neither shall there anything of the flesh, that you sacrificed the FIRST DAY AT EVEN, remain all night until the morning... you shall sacrifice the passover at even, at the going down of the sun..." (Deut. 16:1-7; Matt. 27:45-46).

Here God clearly shows that He considered the Passover sacrifice, done at "the going down of the sun." as the FIRST DAY of the SEVEN DAYS OF UNLEAVENED BREAD! (Mk. 14:12). If we're to blindly follow Church tradition that kills the Passover lamb at the beginning of the 14th, rather than at the end of the 14th, then we end up with EIGHT days of unleavened bread! Does it make sense that the lamb MUST be eaten with unleavened bread and then somehow afterwards for a whole day you can eat leaven again?! How preposterous! At least a child could figure this out! And that's what we all need to become again, like humble little children, hungry for God's truth, eager to please our Father and let His WILL be done, and commandments kept, rather than attempting to defend vain traditions! (Mk. 7:7). God's Word shows that from the end of the 14th (the beginning of the 15th) until the 21st day of the first sacred month is SEVEN DAYS (Ex. 12:18).

The Passover lamb is killed at the end of the 14th and eaten at the beginning of the 15th with unleavened bread: "For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us: Therefore let us keep the feast... with unleavened bread of sincerity and truth" (I Cor. 7-8). Christ is our PASSOVER - not our "Lord's Supper!" Jesus' last supper with His disciples offered Him the perfect opportunity to replace the traditional lamb with a bread and wine ceremony symbolic of His offered body and blood. (Even the rabbis decreed after the Temple's destruction that it was permissible to not eat a Passover lamb).

As we partake of these holy emblems, what are we remembering? Are we commemorating the night of Jesus' betrayal or are we commemorating Jesus' DEATH? We're to eat the BREAD in remembrance of Jesus' body that was sacrificed at the end of the 14th and we're to drink the WINE in remembrance of Jesus' shed blood on our behalf at the end of the 14th (I Cor. 11:23-26). [And Jesus clearly associated His hour of trial and crucifixion with wine, not grape juice! See Jn. 2:3-4]. We're to remember Jesus' sacrifice as our very personal Passover Lamb - the Lamb of God! Passover - with the bread and the wine substituted for the lamb - is the annual holy day, observed at meal time on the evening of the 15th, that commemorates Jesus' sacrifice.

The Passover is both a memorial and a feast (Ex. 12:14). The PASSOVER MEMORIAL is the FIRST of the seven days of unleavened bread (not eight!), and the FIRST of God's seven holy days!

(How would God's Church know when to celebrate God's holy days or even what they are if it weren't for the JEWS? God has made the Jews His custodian and has committed His truths into their care, specifically the Pharisees (Matt. 23:2; Rom. 3:2-3; 9:4). God's holy days are faithfully proclaimed each year "in their seasons" (Lev. 23:4) by His Jewish stewards who keep God's SACRED CALENDAR! How would we know which "season" is which, or which month is the "beginning of months," if God hadn't ordained the JEWS to preserve that knowledge for us? (Gen. 1:14; Ex. 12:2; Rom. 3:2-3).

Thankfully, God's quite capable of ensuring that the Jews - despite themselves will continue to fulfill this special calling (Num. 23:19; Rom. 11:29). So everyone can put away their "calculators" (that only add up to confusion, everybody determining for themselves what's right and what's wrong). God's "business" has a full-time JEWISH ACCOUNTANT who's solely RESPONSIBLE for the calendar. Let's not attempt to interfere with God's business as He's chosen to run it! God - through His Jewish agent - has preserved the knowledge of His holy days and the correct dates to observe them for all who truly want to know and share in celebrating God's truth!

What church will tell you that they have turned a deaf ear to the Spirit of Jesus Christ?

No, these people have willingly deluded themselves, because true faith requires independent thought and independent action and constant attention and work and they are spiritually lazy and proud of their church. If you dare to pierce this cocoon of deception,



in which they have so carefully wrapped themselves—If you expose their nakedness for what it is—do they thank you?

Or do they hate you?

It is difficult to step out of this world and even begin this Christian way of life, but it is even more difficult to maintain it over a span of decades. The pull to return to the values of the world around you never lets up. It requires a great deal of faith to stand alone and be different from the world—to be weird, odd, strange—and to happily remain that way for the rest of your life.

Ultimately, each and every church which Christ has raised up, has succumbed to this pull, and has been reabsorbed by the world. This is an undeniable fact of history—and not really open to debate! So once again, the Church of God is falling prey to this redefined, unbiblical faith of the Protestant world around them. They still retain a form of Godliness, but are denying the power thereof (2 Timothy 3:5).

The TRUE Faith of Christ is a burden they are no longer willing to carry. It is so much easier to maintain a relationship with a church and trust a church, than it is to trust God. It is so much easier to develop a relationship with a man, who cannot see into your heart—such as your minister or your doctor, than it is to develop, and maintain, a deep, personal, honest and sincere relationship with your Creator, who knows your every thought!

But without true faith, it is impossible to please God (**Hebrews 11:6**).

We read in **1 John 3:21-22**, "Beloved, if our heart condemn us not, then have we confidence toward God. And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight."

They have compromised many points of the pure truth that the Holy Spirit has told them and in their hearts, they know this. That's the problem! THEIR OWN HEARTS ARE CONDEMNING THEM!

Now, when they pray, their prayers are no longer answered. When they are anointed, they are no longer healed. Their faith is failing them. They no longer believe that what God promises in His Word, He has bound Himself to perform! When this happens to a person, or a church, they are in grave danger! At this point, Satan has almost won! Unless they acknowledge their sins and their lack of faith, their reward is lost to them!

But such people can almost never admit their own lack of righteousness and faith even to themselves, much less out loud—so through the defensive mechanism of their own vanity, they are forced to conclude that God can not be trusted! This is a pitiful sight!

With faint hope, they cling to a dying church, because it is all they have left. The

pitiful remains of a once vibrant, radiant, and enthusiastic people; filled with hope, excitement, and the faith of Jesus Christ, now sit lifeless, bored, spiritless—clinging to a dead hope—a dead church! It remains as the only reminder of the faith they once had.

They cannot bear the truth. They hate you for telling it to them. They redefined what they used to believe, until they had molded it into a "New Truth" with which they could be comfortable! Now, they are no longer troubled by the "little things" like smoking or like pork gelatin in their foods, or poisoning their children with the bleached white foods and bringing misery and suffering upon them, for the rest of their lives and the lives of their children!

They are no longer troubled by the symbols of the enemies of their Savior decorating their homes and their clothes. They are no longer troubled by showing their homes on the Sabbath or by contractors working for them on the Sabbath or by owning 49% of corporations who sell pork and cigarettes on the Sabbath! Hundreds of other perversions of God's truth abound within the Churches of God today.

Soon they will begin to persecute those who dare to remind them of this or of their former glory. But the truth does not change!

When you accept these false definitions of faith, you have set up an impenetrable barrier which utterly prevents the development of true faith.

As long as you are able to convince yourself that your faith is fine as it is, you will have no need to correct it. If, because of some man's opinion, you accept this false definition of faith, that man has "taken your crown!"

But then brethren, if you do not value God's TRUTH enough to hold on to it, you are not fit to have it, and you will not be in the first resurrection!

God LIKED Job! Never forget that! His opinion is what counts – not YOURS, not your grandmother's, not even (or especially?) your minister's!

Job simply KNEW he wasn't evil. Men have often interpreted this as PRIDE, or Self-Righteousness, but that is not so! It isn't pride to say "I haven't sinned".... when you haven't! It is TRUTH!

Job 10:7 Thou knowest that I am not wicked; and there is none that can deliver out of thine hand.

God agreed! Job was saying what was absolutely true when he said this! God didn't say he was proud, self-righteous, or arrogant! This is what GOD, Himself said about Job!

Job 1:8 And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that there is none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil?

God said Job was perfect! Again, *He* didn't use the term proud or self-righteous, BUT MEN HAVE! And guess where they got the idea? Who was the first to say that Job wasn't TRULY righteous?

Job 1:9-12 Then Satan answered the LORD, and said, Doth Job fear God for nought? Hast not thou made an hedge about him, and about his house, and about all that he hath on every side? thou hast blessed the work of his hands, and his substance is increased in the land. But put forth thine hand now, and touch all that he hath, and he will curse thee to thy face. And the LORD said unto Satan, Behold, all that he hath is in thy power; only upon himself put not forth thine hand. So Satan went forth from the presence of the LORD.

didn't BELIEVE Satan Job righteous! He doesn't believe man CAN be righteous! And so God allowed Satan to kill Job's sons, steal his cattle, and burn his crops. And Job's answer was: Job 1:21-2:3 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD. In all this Job sinned not, nor charged God foolishly. Again there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan came also among them to present himself before the LORD. And the LORD said unto Satan.

"What'r'ya up to?" ... That's paraphrased a bit but I think it catches the meaning fairly well.

From whence comest thou? And Satan answered the LORD, and said, From going to and fro in the earth, and from walking up and down in it. And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that there is none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil? and still he holdeth fast his integrity, although thou movedst me against him, to destroy him WITHOUT CAUSE.

God had no reason to destroy Job's life! God knew it, Satan knew it, and Job knew it! And at first, Job was able to handle this. He knew that he had no right to the blessings of God, that they were a gift, and so he said: Job 2:9-10 Then said his wife unto him, Dost thou still retain thine integrity? curse God, and die. But he said unto her, Thou speakest



as one of the foolish women speaketh. What? shall we receive good at the hand of God, and shall we not receive evil? In all this did not Job sin with his lips.

And so Job took the trial, and passed it! And he was SURE of his righteousness, SURE he hadn't offended God, and so he didn't fear. HOWEVER... as more time passed...

Job knew he had done nothing wrong. And yet the trial continued, longer than he felt it needed to. And so he began wondering if maybe there WAS something he was doing that God was condemning him for. Something he had overlooked.

His friends of course, insisted that there must be something. Eliphaz the Temanite said: **Job 4:7-9** Remember, I pray thee, who ever perished, being innocent? or where were the righteous cut off? Even as I have seen, they that plow iniquity, and sow wickedness, reap the same. By the blast of God they perish, and by the breath of his nostrils are they consumed.

Job's friends were insisting that Job must have sinned – stolen something, cheated someone, DONE SOMETHING wrong. JOB AGREED! But he couldn't find anything!

Job 6:24-25 Teach me, and I will hold my tongue: and cause me to understand wherein I have erred. How forcible are right words! but what doth your arguing reprove?

Job was frustrated with his friends because they explained things to him that any child knew – but he KNEW that he wasn't doing any of those things! And he wanted a REASON! His friends PROVED that good people don't go through this, but WHAT WAS JOB'S SIN?!

Job 10:15 If I be wicked, woe unto me; and if I be righteous, yet will I not lift up my head. I am full of confusion; therefore see thou mine affliction;

Job was just confused! He KNEW that he was righteous. He KNEW righteous people shouldn't be suffering, and yet he was PAINFULLY AWARE that he was suffering! He just wanted answers!

And his friends were more than happy to give him answers... but their answers were not guided by God!

Job 4:12-19 Now a thing was secretly brought to me, and mine ear received a little thereof. In thoughts from the visions of the night, when deep sleep falleth on men, Fear came upon me, and trembling, which made all my bones to shake. Then a spirit passed before my face; the hair of my flesh stood up: It stood still, but I could not discern the form thereof: an image was before mine eyes, there was silence, and I heard a voice, saying, Shall mortal man be more just than God? shall a man be more pure than his maker? Behold, he put no trust in his

servants; HIS ANGELS HE CHARGED WITH FOLLY: How much LESS in them that dwell in houses of clay, whose foundation is in the dust, which are crushed before the moth?

This was not a righteous angel! This was a messenger sent by Satan! Remember, God was staying out of this. He told Satan to do whatever he wanted, as long as he didn't kill Job. And when you think of a spirit causing the hair on your flesh to stand up, you think of witchcraft and horror movies — NOT a righteous messenger from God!

Furthermore, who, of all the beings in heaven or earth, would say "God didn't even trust His angels – He accused ME of folly – and you think YOU are going to do better??"

God has only accused ONE ANGEL (and his followers) of folly! Only ONE chose to do evil, and was punished for it! Satan FAILED TO BE RIGHTEOUS! And he knows that he is made out of light, while you and I are made out of MUD. And his reasoning is, if HE failed, do you honestly think YOU can be perfect??

The mistake made by Eliphaz the Temanite and his friends was that HE DIDN'T TRY THE SPIRITS! Just because you have a dream, doesn't mean God sent it!

1 John 4:1 Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.

You need to TEST these spirits! To find out if God sent them or not! Eliphaz didn't do this!

Isaiah 8:19 And when they shall say unto you, Seek unto them that have familiar spirits, and unto wizards that peep, and that mutter: should not a people seek unto their God? for the living to the dead?

That makes sense doesn't it? Shouldn't people seek their God? Of course!

Verse 20 To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them.

But even though it sounds good, even if this vision SOUNDED RIGHT, they needed to check it against the law and the testimony! If they HAD, they would have found that man WAS supposed to be GOD! That he WAS supposed to be perfectly, incorruptibly righteous, JUST LIKE HIS MAKER! Then they would have rejected this vision as the LIE THAT IT WAS!

Instead, you will find that every argument used by Job's friends uses this vision as a premise!

To summarize what we have so far, Job was righteous, without fault. Satan didn't believe this, although he couldn't prove it. He sent a vision to Job's friends to show that man CAN'T BE RIGHTEOUS, and so they based their arguments on that premise... and Job just wanted an answer! He just wanted to

know WHY this was happening to him, so he could fix it!

And since Job knew that God was just, and fair, he knew that somewhere he must be doing something wrong. So he began going farther and farther back in his life, and wondering if perhaps God hadn't yet forgiven him for something he'd done before.

Job 7:21 And why dost thou not pardon my transgression, and take away mine iniquity? for now shall I sleep in the dust; and thou shalt seek me in the morning, but I shall not be.

And all the while, Job's friends continued to tell him that which was blatantly obvious.

Job 11:13-16 If thou prepare thine heart, and stretch out thine hands toward him; If iniquity be in thine hand, put it far away, and let not wickedness dwell in thy tabernacles. For then shalt thou lift up thy face without spot; yea, thou shalt be stedfast, and shalt not fear: Because thou shalt forget thy misery, and remember it as waters that pass away:

Job 12:1-3 And Job answered and said, No doubt but ye are the people, and wisdom shall die with you. But I have understanding as well as you; I am not inferior to you: yea, who KNOWETH NOT such things as these?

And Job's response was... DUH... EVERYONE KNOWS THIS! But I HAVEN'T DONE THOSE THINGS! And this theme continued for another 25 chapters or so.

Job 13:23 How many are mine iniquities and sins? make me to know my transgression and my sin. Wherefore hidest thou thy face, and holdest me for thine enemy? Wilt thou break a leaf driven to and fro? and wilt thou pursue the dry stubble? For thou writest bitter things against me, and makest me to possess the iniquities of my youth.

Job was in a quandary. He knew of no sins, and yet the trial continued. Backed into a corner, his only apparent option was to start to question the things he had done as a youth – were they forgiven? Or was God going to remember them? Was *that* what this was about?

And when he had come up with that idea, he wanted to talk to God. He was sure he could sort it out if only he could argue with God face-to-face. There is a record of someone else who was backed into this same corner.

Matthew 27:46 And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?

Christ was without sin – and yet, hanging on the stake, God pulled back from him for a minute. Imagine what was going through Christ's head. "I've never done anything



wrong. Now I am being tortured, and to top it all off, God has left me."

Analogous to Job, is it not? The difference is, when Christ was in this trial He looked back and could find nothing, EVER, that God might, even possibly be able to hold against him. And SO HE KNEW that the trial WASN'T BECAUSE OF GOD NOT FORGIVING HIS SIN, and was able to TRUST GOD.

1 Peter 2:23 Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed himself to him that judgeth righteously:

JOB DIDN'T DO THIS! And THAT was Job's MISTAKE! God pulled back from Christ to see if Christ would still do the right thing if He wasn't there holding his hand! Similarly, Job was perfectly righteous. And God needed to know if Job would do the right thing, and TRUST HIM, in the face of adversity!

Job 35:14-16 Although thou sayest thou shalt not see him, yet judgment is before him; therefore TRUST THOU IN HIM. But now, BECAUSE IT IS NOT SO, he hath visited in his anger; yet he knoweth it not in great extremity: Therefore doth Job open his mouth in vain; he multiplieth words without knowledge.

This is the reason for Job's trial, the reason for Job's answers, and the reason for God's answers in Job 38-41! Job DIDN'T TRUST GOD WHEN IT CAME RIGHT DOWN TO THE WIRE!

Most of the middle portion of the book of Job is arguing between Job and his friends, Job maintaining that he hadn't sinned, and asking God why he is being unfair, and Job's friends saying man cannot be righteous and Job MUST be sinning somehow. Finally, Job's friends gave up trying to argue with him. Elihu had said nothing up to this point, but finally, he was fed up and started talking. And THEN Job began to get answers.

Job 32:1-3 So these three men ceased to answer Job, because he was righteous in his own eyes. Then was kindled the wrath of Elihu the son of Barachel the Buzite, of the kindred of Ram: against Job was his wrath kindled, because he justified himself rather than God. Also against his three friends was his wrath kindled, because they had found no answer, and yet had condemned Job.

Elihu was mad at both parties! Job's friends had wasted 30 chapters proving that God doesn't punish the righteous, and yet had made no effort to show Job WHAT he was doing wrong! They WASTED THEIR TIME AND HIS!

Job on the other hand, had begun to justify Himself rather than God. He had begun not to trust God. He had started out

fine, but once he had EXAMINED himself, and PROVEN that he was not wicked, he should have left it in God's hands.

Instead, he started to think that God hadn't forgiven his past sins. Instead of knowing that, since he WAS righteous, God was still his friend and had a plan... He said things like: Job 33:9-12 I am clean without transgression, I am innocent; neither is there iniquity in me. Behold, he findeth occasions against me, he counteth me for his enemy, He putteth my feet in the stocks, he marketh all my paths. [Elihu talking now] Behold, in this thou art not just: I will answer thee, that God is greater than man.

We know from the words of God himself that Job saying he was innocent, without transgression wasn't wrong! That WASN'T A SIN! But we do know that saying that God was treating him as an enemy was wrong! God had not put his feet in the stocks, nor counted him as an enemy!

This was all orchestrated and planned by God to show Job something. It was to show him one last lesson. It wasn't that he had a sin which needed correcting — Job WAS perfect — it was to teach him to trust God, and to be righteous NO MATTER WHAT.

Job 42:5-6 I have heard of thee by the hearing of the ear: but now mine eye seeth thee. Wherefore I abhor myself, and repent in dust and ashes.

Bottom line, Job had reached a point in his righteousness where he needed to be tempered. Just like Christ was on the stake. You can create and shape a sword in a forge, and you can sharpen it – but it will dull as soon as you use it! Until you TEMPER it, it is useless!

Job's righteousness was PERFECT – but it was not TEMPERED! Once Job had been perfectly righteous, *then he* was able to look back, after the trial, and see it slipping away... once he had seen himself, in the absence of the blessings of God, almost immediately he began not trusting God...

He abhorred himself, and repented! And because of this memory, God and Job both knew that in a situation like this, no matter WHAT trial he went through, Job would TRUST God now! And that was the purpose, the REASON, for the trails of Job!

But what was Job's mistake, and what can YOU learn from this? This was the question that once plagued me. What WAS Job's mistake? Simply stated, not clouded in the opinions and flowery words that I've seen so often. What SHOULD he have done, that he didn't? And here is the answer for which I sought...

Job 34:31-32 Surely it is meet to be said unto God, I have borne chastisement, I will not offend any more: That which I see not teach thou me: if I have done iniquity, I will do no more.

That is what Job SHOULD HAVE SAID! And there is YOUR ANSWER... should you ever face this situation. But quite frankly, right now this is almost certainly NOT the right answer for you!

If you haven't examined yourself THOROUGHLY, this is the WRONG ANSWER! If you aren't SURE of your righteousness, if your heart condemns you about ANYTHING, AT ALL... this will only heap God's disgust upon you even higher!

This answer is ONLY to be used after you are CERTAIN that you have stopped everything you are doing that might, even POSSIBLY be wrong. Remember, Job had already done this!

Job 31:1-13 I made a covenant with mine eyes; why then should I think upon a maid?... If I have walked with vanity, or if my foot hath hasted to deceit; Let me be weighed in an even balance, that God may know mine integrity. If my step hath turned out of the way, and mine heart walked after mine eyes, and if any blot hath cleaved to mine hands; Then let me sow, and let another eat; yea, let my offspring be rooted out. If mine heart have been deceived by a woman, or if I have laid wait at my neighbour's door; Then let my wife grind unto another, and let others bow down upon her. For this is an heinous crime; yea, it is an iniquity to be punished by the judges. For it is a fire that consumeth to destruction, and would root out all mine increase. If I did despise the cause of my manservant or of my maidservant, when they contended with me...

And Job continues throughout the chapter, and indeed, the entire book of Job, most of his words are saying something like this. Because Job knew that he had to examine himself to be righteous! He had to PROVE HIMSELF! He had to KNOW that he hadn't offended God! And when he was punished for no apparent reason, he went to the SOURCE of the problem – himself!

If you haven't done that, then saying "I have borne chastisement, I will offend no more" is a flat-out LIE! And God will see it as such, and punish you even more! So you should be VERY CAREFUL using those words unless you are SURE, beyond ANY DOUBT, that you are not offending God!

But if you are, then that is the right answer for you.

Job 42:7-8 And it was so, that after the LORD had spoken these words unto Job, the LORD said to Eliphaz the Temanite, My wrath is kindled against thee, and against thy two friends: for ye have not spoken of me the thing that is right, as my servant Job hath. Therefore take unto you now seven bullocks and seven rams, and go to my servant Job, and offer up for yourselves a burnt offering; and my servant Job shall pray

for you: for HIM WILL I ACCEPT: lest I deal with you after your folly, in that ye have not spoken of me the thing which is right, like my servant Job.

Which thing God said to prove once and for all that man CAN be as righteous as God, and that all of their arguments to the contrary were lies!

you are crossing the Jordan to possess." Deuteronomy 31:9-13.

Regarding training our children is the most important thing – proper respect for the living Word of God -- this is the most important command to the church as a whole! We have not obeyed it – a major reason for the shameful failures of our religious tradition. We have followed men following mere natural instincts, and not the Spirit of God, in neglecting this supremely important command and practice.

It is needful for the church to support parents in their spiritual ministry of parenthood and children themselves in their own spiritual struggles. Our responsibility is to help Christ – by our service to Him in serving each other -- "to redeem us from all wickedness and to purify for himself a people that are his very own, eager to do what is good" (Titus 2:13b-14). For this very reason He gave himself for us!

Children need to be prepared for the day when they will "leave ... father and mother" (Genesis 2:24) to establish their own families. For this preparation process, God wants strong, committed marriages dedicated to producing "godly offspring". Speaking of marriage, the Scripture says: "Has not the LORD made them one? In flesh and spirit they are his. And why one? Because he was seeking godly offspring. So guard yourself in your spirit, and do not break faith with the wife of your youth. "I hate divorce," says the LORD God of Israel..." (Malachi 2:15-16a).

God is "seeking godly offspring"! We have neglected to give nearly enough attention to this desire of His!

Anything we do to support godliness in marriage is good for children.

With regard to the "sowing and reaping" of our lives, we are enjoined: "Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers." (Galatians 6:10). It is the Church's responsibility "to do good" with

regard to training our children:

Whatever we can do to support parents to fulfill the command to raise children "in the training and instruction of the LORD.' (Ephesians 6:4). That also includes encouraging children to respect and obey their parents, to cooperate in God's purpose for them.

Whatever prayer, encouragement, or teaching we can give to help fathers, especially, attain the ideal of "with true dignity keeping his children in submission" (1 Timothy 3:4, Hendriksen) is part of that good.

Ideas:

Special events that are wholesome for children (Good Science Seminar, Monterey Bay Aquarium trip, special parties, etc.)

Subsidize camp and other special wholesome experiences for children.

We need more of an emphasis on materials for children and to support parents in our Church library. Our children are faced with a world overflowing with bad influences. We need to give more attention to specifically addressing and combating them.

Bible Contradictions

The first thing to firmly fix in your mind prior to studying the Bible is that God's written word is truth and there are no contradictions in what he has caused to be written.

Jesus said of God's word, "Your word is truth" (Jn. 17:17) and "The scripture cannot be broken" (Jn. 10:35). God inspired the Bible to be written and it is impossible for God to lie (Heb. 6:18; Tit. 1:2); therefore, God's word will always be true (Rom. 3:4).

The problem with seemingly contradictory scriptures is never with what God has inspired to be written; it is always with people's perspective or understanding of what has been written or with how it has been translated or interpreted from the original writing.

Consider this for a moment: If God is a God of truth who cannot lie and he has said that he inspired and instructed his prophets, servants, and apostles to record all that is his sacred word, there cannot be any errors, lies, or contradictions in his originally inspired written word.

Solving Contradictions

Seemingly unsolvable scriptural contradictions are normally the product of

one or more of the following:

- An error in translation from the original language.
- An error in the interpretation of the original language.
- Insufficient research on the subject.
- Translated from an erroneous or incomplete copy of the original text.

Because the above conditions may exist, doctrine should never be established by using vague or difficult to understand scriptures. All major teachings of the Bible, such as those concerning God and his plan of salvation, should be expounded with clear concise statements that prove their validity to anyone whom God is calling to salvation.

Textual Errors

A major error that should be avoided when studying the Bible and related documents is the belief that the more ancient a manuscript or a document is, the more accurate it is. This is a very dangerous assumption to make. Just because a document is ancient, does not make it accurate. The test of accuracy is the test of truth and the continuity of truth. If an ancient writing does not conform to proven Biblical truth and departs from the overall theme and continuity of the Bible, it should not be used to establish doctrine.

Because no original writings of the scriptures are available and centuries have passed since their writing, all modern translations and interpretations of the original text contain some error due to one or more of the following:

- Additions or omissions due to private interpretation
- Justification by translators for false teaching
- Lack of attention to detail
- Lack of the correct linguistic information
- Poor scholarship

Truth Will Endure

God has promised that his truth will never be lost. Although there may be copy errors or translation errors of the original writings, the truth and the will of God can still be found and understood by those to whom he chooses to reveal it. See Jer. 33:3; Lk. 11:9-13; Jn. 14:26; 16:12-13; 1 Cor. 2:9-16.

The Bible Interprets Itself

Trying to justify preconceived ideas and beliefs are a major obstacle to gaining a correct understanding of any biblical subject. The proper approach to understanding the Bible should be an open-minded, unbiased attempt to understand what is truly written and not what a person thinks is written. However, this is very difficult to do because



of the vast amount of false teaching about God and the Bible today.

Because of the way the Bible has been written, it will literally interpret itself if you are willing to collect all of the relevant facts and references and let the holy spirit guide your mind into truth.

Precept upon Precept

Those who think that the Bible sometimes contradicts itself have failed to understand that the Bible is a complex book, which must be studied as a whole if its mysteries are to be understood.

One of the most fascinating and inspiring aspects of the Bible's construction is the way various subjects are interwoven throughout its pages. Because of this, it is sometimes necessary to collect all of the references to a subject before you can begin to understand what is being taught: "For precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, and there a little" (Isa. 28:10 KJV). See also Isa. 28:9-13.

Continuity of Truth

There is a continuity of truth throughout the entire Bible which is very helpful in separating truth from error. Each specific teaching or doctrine of the Bible will conform to the overall theme and purpose of the entire Bible. If any teaching or doctrine is found to be in conflict with another, one or both of the teachings may be based upon false assumptions or incorrectly understood scriptures.

Acquiring Knowledge and Understanding

Many feel that a person must be highly educated or very intelligent to understand the Bible, but this is not true. All those whom the Father calls to salvation can understand what he has caused to be written for their inspiration, correction, and edification. Because the Father wants his children to succeed in their calling and to perform his will in their lives, he has provided a way for them to learn and understand his truth.

Among the many promises Jesus makes to those who believe in him, is that he will send the holy spirit as a teacher to guide them into truth. See Jn. 14:26; 16:12-13.

One way that the holy spirit carries out teaching and guiding is through the written word of God. The acquisition of truth, spiritual knowledge, and understanding with the help of the holy spirit requires effort on the part of the one being called to study the Bible and related information.

Whom Shall God Teach?

"Whom shall he teach knowledge? and whom shall he make to understand doctrine? them that are weaned from the milk, and drawn from the breasts" (Isa. 28:9).

Just as there is a physical growth process from infancy to adulthood, there is a spiritual growth process in the acquisition of spiritual knowledge and understanding. The more you learn and the more you practice what you have learned, the more spiritually mature you become and the more spiritual knowledge and understanding God can reveal to you. See Isa. 66:1-2.

STUDY FOR SPIRITUAL GROWTH

If you only study the Bible for information, very little understanding that is profitable for spiritual growth will be gained. However, your studies will become spiritually profitable if you study the Bible in order to do the following things:

- To understand the Father's plan for humanity
- To know the Father's will in your life
- To learn what the Father expects of you
- To grow toward spiritual maturity
- To serve the Father and his children
- To understand how to fulfill your particular calling

If you study the Bible for these reasons, the Father will honor your request for him to reveal the mysteries of the Bible that will benefit you and others with whom you come into contact.

Prerequisites and Requirements

The Bible itself reveals the prerequisites and requirements that are necessary to be successful in its study. The following are some of the major things that you must do in order to acquire more knowledge and a deeper understanding of God the Father, Jesus Christ, and their awesome plan for humanity:

- Ask the Father for spiritual knowledge and understanding.
- Have a serious desire to understand the things of God and study with an open mind.
- Make what is learned a part of your life.
- Meditate on God's law in order to improve spiritual understanding.
- Remember and practice the things which are already understood to be the truth of God.
- Remove obstacles to learning by putting away improper attitudes and behavior.
- Study to grow spiritually, to serve others, and to fulfill your calling.

Remove Obstacles to Learning

The Apostle Peter lists some of the things that hamper spiritual growth which should be replaced with a desire to

understand God's truth and way of truth: "Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speaking, as newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that you may grow thereby" (1 Pet. 2:1-2 Para.).

In order to gain understanding into the more difficult things of God, you must be practicing the basic truths of God in your life: "But whoever keeps his [God's] word, in him truly is the love of God perfected..." (1 Jn. 2:5 KJV).

Meditate on God's Word

"Blessed is the man that walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful. But his delight is in the law of the Lord; and in his law does he meditate day and night" (Psa. 1:1-2 KJV). See also Psa. 119:115-148; 1 Tim. 4:12-16.

There are tremendous blessings for those who perform the will of God in their life. The person who is being blessed loves God and his law (i.e., God's way of life) and is constantly thinking about both.

Prove all Things

"Test all things; and hold fast that which is good" (1 Thes. 5:21 Para.). See also Rom. 12:2.

This statement is in the context of a person doing the Father's will in their life. Paul refers to the testing or examining of what you are doing in your life and comparing it against the righteous standards of behavior that the Father has established. Notice that Paul says to "Hold fast that which is good". You can only know what is good if you understand the word of God. Therefore, you must study the Bible in order to fulfill Paul's instruction.

The kind of true enduring belief that the Father desires for his children to have is based in the knowledge and understanding of him and his ways. The only place this kind of knowledge and understanding is available is in the Bible.

The Bible was written to be understood; it is not a book of theory, philosophy, or meaningless stories; it is a logical factual presentation of the things that God wants his children to know, understand, and practice.

PLAN FOR SUCCESS

An action plan containing goals for spiritual success is a valuable tool that can help you maintain focus on your goals to grow in the Father's truth and to perform your stewardship within his family. The following are some tips on how to develop a personal plan for spiritual success, some important subjects to make a part of your study plan, and some important attitudes and behaviors to cultivate as you learn and practice the

Father's truth and way of truth:

- 1.Write your plan in a binder or hard bound book in order to more easily store, access, review, and edit it.
- 2.Make a list of topics categories, and sub-topics to study and things to accomplish, such as attitudes and behaviors that need to be cultivated and become a part of your character and unrighteous attitudes and behaviors that need to be discarded. The items in this list should be clearly defined and simply stated.
- 3.Leave enough space under each item in your list or place each item on a separate piece of paper in order for you to keep your notes and comments close to each item.
- 4. Prioritize your list and check off items as you complete them.
- Make your action plan a flexible tool that you can modify periodically to fit your needs.
- 6.Review your plan often in order to check your progress and add or edit items to maintain focus on your goals.

THE STUDY PLAN

Regardless of how you structure your action plan for learning and understanding the Father's truth and will for your life, a high priority should be given to reading the entire Bible from cover to cover at least once.

There are many translations of the Bible and each has its own particular strengths and weaknesses. Some help clarify difficult scriptures and concepts, while others do the opposite--they introduce heretical teachings. Because there is no totally accurate translation of the original text, the admonition of Paul to Timothy becomes very important to those who are serious about building a strong spiritual foundation based upon the word of God: "Study to show yourself approved to God, a workman that needs not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth" (2 Tim. 2:15).

No Original Text Available

When reading the Bible, it is important to remember that there are no original copies of the various writings which comprise the Bible available for use by Bible scholars or the general public. Therefore, it is impossible to confirm or deny what was originally written with physical evidence. What we have today are copies of the originals and translations of these copies.

The King James Version

The King James Authorized Version of the Old and the New Testaments, written in early modern English in 1611, was translated from the Masoretic text and the Received text. From the historical evidence and the continuity of truth that is revealed through both the Masoretic text and the Received text, it appears that both of these are reference works through which God is conveying his truth and his will today.

Because of the King James Versions' archaic language, it is helpful to have some modern translations along with Greek and Hebrew dictionaries in order to help clarify difficult passages. The New International Version and the Living Bible can sometimes be helpful in translating concepts that are difficult to understand because of the language of the King James version. You may also find it helpful to purchase a narrated version of the Bible to listen to while reading, while traveling, or while being unoccupied with other endeavors.

Topical Studies

Many people take one scripture (sometimes out of context) and build an entire teaching around it. However, the Prophet Isaiah tells us that God's truth is scattered throughout his written word (Isa. 28:9-13) and that these truths, concepts, and principles are built one on the other. Therefore, it seems logical that you must perform a search of the entire Bible in order to gain a thorough understanding of a subject. Personally, I have found that topical studies are the best way to understand the teachings contained in the Bible.

GOD'S LAW

A short review of the first five books of the Bible clearly reveal that God is a God of law. The agreement with the twelve tribes of national Israel contains 613 to 759 plus statutes, judgments, and commandments, depending on who is doing the counting. The special agreement that the Sovereign Father has with his earthly family of king-priests also contains laws and instructions that govern their relationship with him, their relationship with brothers and sisters in his holy family, and with other people.

A study of the law with the goal of understanding both the letter and the spirit of the law will give insight into the minds of the Sovereign Father and our Savior, their character, attitude, and behavior. Moreover, these laws reveal how one who is attempting to live a holy lifestyle should think and behave.

Love Toward God

The first laws given to national Israel were the Ten Commandments. Matthew and Mark both record that Christ said the whole law was held together by just two commandments-- love for God and love for neighbor: "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and

with all your mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is similar to it, You shall love your neighbor as yourself. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets" (Matt 22:37- 40 KJV). See also Mk. 12:28-34.

If you truly have love and respect for your heavenly Father, you will want to please him with your life by following Jesus' example of a righteous life. The Father said of Christ at his baptism, "This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased" (Matt. 3:17).

The scriptures show us that love and respect for the Father are expressed through one's attitude and behavior toward him and obedience and respect for the law he has set in place to govern the lives of his children. Regarding his behavior toward the Father, Jesus said, "For I do always those things that please him" (Jn. 8:29).

Concerning the expression of godly love, the apostle John said, "By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments. For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous" (1 Jn. 5:2-3).

All of God's law for mankind hinge on the two basic themes of love for God and love for neighbor, but there are many overlapping concepts and principles contained within this body of law which explain and expound upon these two basic themes.

ATTITUDES AND BEHAVIORS

The scriptures instruct the Father's children to subdue and keep in check their old nature which is in opposition to the holy nature imparted through the indwelling of the holy spirit. See Rom. 6:6-12; Eph. 4:21-24: Col. 3:9-10.

The apostles Peter and Paul list a number of righteous attitudes and behaviors that need to be cultivated and become a part of your character and a number of unrighteous attitudes and behaviors that need to be discarded. Many of these altitudes and behaviors are noted in the following scriptures and are worthy of careful study: 1 Pet. 2:1; Rom. 13:11-14; 1 Cor. 13:11; Eph. 4:21-32; Col. 3:3-15.

Cultivate charity, forgiveness, honesty, humility, kindness, longsuffering, meekness, mercy, peace, tenderheartedness, and truthfulness.

Discard anger, bitterness, blasphemy, drunkenness, envy, evil desires, extortion, filthy speech, fornication, guile, hypocrisy, idolatry, inordinate affection, lying, malice, rioting, theft, uncleanness, and wrath.

Added to the list of attitudes and behaviors to be discarded are things that are clearly in opposition to a righteous lifestyle, such as some personal associations, habits, hobbies, as well as religious holidays, festivals, and celebrations that belong to this world's religions. See 1 Pet. 1:15-16; Deut. 12:30-32: Jer. 10:1-15.

Rules of Conduct

Although, it is important to become conversant with all aspects of the Father's truth, there are some basic rules of conduct that apply within his family which need to be clearly understood and practiced if you are to grow spiritually and become a viable and beneficial member of his family. These rules of conduct and the philosophy behind them are set forth in the Bible as the standards of acceptable and unacceptable attitudes and behaviors for all members of the Father's family.

Each of these rules are clearly spelled out in many scriptures and should be among the first things you learn and make a part of your lifestyle as a member of the Father's earthly family. Without knowing and understanding these rules of conduct, it is virtually impossible to be a good steward of the functions and responsibilities that you have been called to perform. Moreover, these rules also reveal how to express love (i.e., an outgoing concern) for family members and produce peace and harmony within the family. The apostle John said the following about walking in truth (i.e., following the Father's rules for your life) and the rule to love one another within the family: "I rejoiced greatly that I found of your children walking in truth, as we have received a commandment from the Father. And now I beseech vou. lady, not as though I wrote a new commandment to you, but that which we had from the beginning, that we love one another. And this is love, that we walk after his commandments. This is the commandment, That, as you have heard from the beginning, you should walk in it... Beloved, if God so loved us, we ought also to love one another" (2 Jn. 4-6 KJV). See also Gal. 5:13-14; 1 Pet. 1:22. 2:17: Jms. 2:8: 1 Jn. 3:13-16. 4:20-21.

Although some of the rules of conduct are clearly intended to be applied to individuals occupying positions of service within the family or are gender specific, most apply in principle to all family members regardless of position of service or gender. The following are some of these rules of conduct with which each member should be conversant and practice as a part of their stewardship within the family:

General Rules:

- Attitude and behavior toward doctrinally deceptive individuals (2 Jn. 2:4-11)
- Commandment keeping (1 Jn. 5:1-3)
- Compassion (1 Pet. 3:8; 1 Jn. 3:17-18)

- Forbearance and forgiveness (Matt. 5:23-24; Lk. 17:3-4; Eph. 4:32; Col. 3:13)
- Honor/Respect/Value other people: (Eph. 6:2; 1 Tim. 5:3; 1 Pet. 2:17, 3:7)
- Love for each family member (Rom. 12:9-10; 1 Pet. 4:7-8; 1 Jn. 4:21)
- Patience (Eph. 4:2)
- Reconciliation (Matt. 5:21-24)

By your last statement, you clearly know exactly which part of the article was referred to as being plagiarized.

Arlan writes:

Darwin & Laura write:

Clearly you are stating that you did copy pages 7 and 8 from another article. At this time since we sent you an email clearly telling you that we know you plagiarized two pages of material from another article, having been caught at this, you are now willing to give credit to the one you quoted from. Clearly you knew you were copying from someone else, and yet you tried to pass this off as work you had done on your own. Instead of originally trying to pass this off as your own work, you should have given credit to the person who's work you copied. This shows intent on your part. Intent that you fully planned to let anyone reading the article believe that you had actually done the work yourself, when in fact you had not. This is also deception in that you intended to have those who read your article believe that you had done the research yourself, when in fact you had not.



Arlan writes:

If, on the other hand, I've gone ahead and verified the authenticity of these locations, then I don't believe it would be plagiarism... no more than when I quote Scripture.

Darwin & Laura write:

The pivotal word "if" as used here is what tipped us off that you had not verified any of these quotes. This is another deception on your part. It is an attempt on your part to con those reading your above statement into believing that you had looked up the guotes and so therefore now it should not be considered to be plagiarism. You justify your position by saying it is now plagiarism also to quote Scripture, which is about as absurd as you can get. Those who copy Scripture are not deceiving people into believing that they wrote the Scriptures and that is the difference. Most people understand that God inspired all scriptures to be written by chosen writers.

From the Dictionary: Plagiarize=#1. to take and pass off as one's own (the ideas, writings, etc. of another). #2. to take ideas, writings, etc. from and pass them off as one's own. (Webster's New World Dictionary of the American Language, College Edition)

No matter which way you slice this your original intent was to copy from another man's article a series of statements he

researched and put together in an orderly fashion and then make it look like it was you who had done this. This is called plagiarism. You stole another man's work (idea) and tried to pass it off as your own. This is not only stealing, but it is also deception of the highest form and shows that you fully intended to con people reading your article into believing something which was not true.

anyone. The same applies also to women, in that not all women should be leaders or teachers.

What makes a man or a women a leader or teacher of God's word is that they have the spirit of God in them. If a person man or women starts leading people away from God, consider them to be false teachers. If however you just don't agree with something they have written or said, it is your responsibility then to try to teach them according to scripture, but make sure you do your own study on the subject first to make sure that what you disagree with is truly false or if your own belief system is the true problem.

Not all men can be public speakers or ministers. Okay, the web site--Will this be your first web site? If so, I won't tell you it is an easy thing. When I first did a web site several years ago, I didn't know anything about it or how it worked. I have learned a lot over the years. My first Web Site was done with "Ixla Web Easy Millennium", some things did not work correctly in their software but it was easy to understand and I was sorry when they went out of business. Then I discovered that "Ixla Web Easy Millennium" was bought by Vcom and later sold as "Web Easy 5 Professional". This program was great and they corrected the glitches in the Ixla version of the software. The entire web site is all my design. The web easy software allows you to do almost anything one wants as far as design. Some of the stuff included in the software I have never used because I either don't know how or just haven't had time to even look at it. So I by no means know how to work everything included in this software. Live, Love and Laugh!

I feel compelled to share with all of you a message that has been "gifted" to me this week, from our highest source of knowledge, our Father of the Heavens and Earth.

Brian and I have been trying to combat a problem in our children for about a year now— negativity and temper, especially toward studies (a serious issue because it can lead to an unfulfilling, unhealthy life literally/physically/mentally). We have tried many techniques, such as punishing, taking things and blessings away, using scripture with our punishments, making the kids go outside or to a window to throw the bad out, talking/questioning it all out, and many other antics to get the "bad" out of our children. We began to pray, talk, and meditate over the issue just recently, digging deep into our resources to find an answer (and we seemed to be becoming more frustrated with the idea).

Then, while at Sabbath services this past week, it came in the most unexpected way. The answer was in the sermon! It was just the way our Father is—SIMPLE! Parents, we make things to hard for ourselves, and then we cannot see the answers that he gives us. We ask and He gives! If our minds are open, and letting his life live in us, everything would look very simple to us and our answers would come to us as easy as an interrogative conversation with someone! OK, here is the simple answer: correction in Love. Rewards in Love (Honey character, not Vinegar, they look the same yet smell different) All of Yahweh's commands and ways of living are very simple. You all can look into the Bible and read the examples of the servants, disciples, Solomon, apostles, and so on, to see how they asked for answers and the answer was simple, or the knowledge was immediate when minds were open to it (many examples show how some 'thought too much' and the answer was right in front of them).

Here are some "new" things we are going back to doing (as we did when the kids were younger, that worked better) and I hope that they help you in your 'training up your children in the way they should go'. We correct ourselves, **in respect**, and God corrects us constantly, **in respect**, so we should do the same to our children. Gal. 5, Prov. 27:19, I Cor. 14:26, 40:--, Matt 18, Act 2, Prov 15, Rom 13-14 AWSOME! God's word the heavens existed and the earth was formed ...[and that] the world of that time was deluged and destroyed... [and that] the present heavens and earth are reserved for fire, being kept for the day of judgment and destruction of ungodly men" (2 Peter 3:3, 5-7 NIV). "In the last days scoffers deliberately forget" -- he says, writing centuries ago -- the historical record of the Scriptures, how man was created and the great flood that destroyed the world that then was -- considering those records merely

myths, stories of ignorant men. Even more so, he says, "in the last days scoffers deliberately forget" the warnings that the Creator is also Judge and intends to destroy all that is evil and create a new heaven and earth much better than this one, sullied as it is by deep dishonesty and sin. Modern scoffers prefer the opposing story of "Molecules to Man" fabricated "by science falsely so-called" (1 Timothy 6:20 KJV) according to "Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the command of God our Savior and of Christ Jesus our hope" -- or perhaps it was some other delusional maniac. For sure, he wrote many hundreds of years ago.

The big fisherman also says: "We did not follow cleverly invented stories when we told you about the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we were eyewitnesses of his majesty." But, if as an actual eyewitness to the power and majesty of our Creator, Redeemer and rightful Judge -- Peter is telling the real truth and knows whereof he speaks, because both he and the rest of those who wrote the "stories" of Scripture really did speak "from God as were carried along by the Holy Spirit" (2 Peter 1:21) -- then "what kind of people ought you to be? You ought to live holy and godly lives as you look forward to the day of God" -- the day of judgment and "a new heaven and a new earth, the home of righteousness" -- "and speed its coming." (2 Peter 3:11, 13 NIV).
